

**MEDICARE BENEFICIARY
PRIVATE CONTRACT FOR MEDICAL BENEFITS**

THIS MEDICARE BENEFICIARY PRIVATE CONTRACT FOR MEDICAL SERVICES, (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, _____ **between Andrew T. Goldstein, M.D., and Andrew T. Goldstein, M.D.** (referred to either collectively or individually as the "Provider"), and _____ (patient and any legal Representative of patient will be referred to in the Agreement as the "Patient").

RECITALS

- A. Provider has elected to opt-out of the Medicare program for the period from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2012, and has filed an Affidavit with the proper Medicare Carrier as required by law.
- B. Patient is a beneficiary under the Medicare program and wishes to receive Medical services from Provider.
- C. Patient and Provider are required by the Social Security Act to enter into this Agreement before Provider furnishes any medical services to Patient that might be otherwise covered under Medicare.

AGREEMENT

The Provider and the Patient agree as follows:

- 1. Provider has not been excluded from the Medicare Program under any Provisions of the Social Security Act.
- 2. Patient accepts full responsibility for payment of charges for all services and Items furnished by Provider.
- 3. Patient understands that the Medicare limits do not apply to what the Provider May charge for services or items furnished by the Provider. Charges for services and items provided will be based on a fee schedule set by Provider. The fee schedule is available for review on request.
- 4. Patient will not submit a claim to Medicare for the services or items furnished By Provider, and will not ask Provider to submit such a claim.
- 5. Patient understands that Medicare payment will not be made for services or Items furnished by Provider, even if that would have otherwise been covered by Medicare if Patient and Provider had not entered into this Agreement and a Proper claim had been submitted.
- 6. Patient understands that she has the right, at any time, to obtain medical Services and items from a physician who has not opted-out of Medicare, and Patient understands that she is not required to enter into private contracts with other physicians who have not opted-out.
