Required for all mid-level management federal, state, local, tribal, private sector & nongovernmental personnel to include: persons serving as command staff, section chiefs, strike team leaders, task force leaders, unit leaders, division/group supervisors, branch directors, and multi-agency coordination system/emergency operations center staff. Training will include ICS Staffing and Organization, Transfer of Command, Unified Command functions in a multi-jurisdictional or multi-agency incident, ICS forms, Resource Management and Interagency mission planning and procurement.
