What is a Crop Session?

Many new scrapbookers ask this question.

A crop session is where you bring your own photos, scrapbooking supplies and tools and come to the shop to be inspired by other scrapbookers. It's a great way to get new ideas and help for those pages you might be stuck on or simply to get through all those layouts you've been meaning to do. New scrapbookers are always welcome to crop sessions. However, we recommend taking at least one class to see what it's all about, especially if you don't own the basics such as a cutter or adhesive and want to have personalized attention when getting started.

1. Crop sessions are held every **Tues, Wed and Thurs morning from 9:30-12:30** and at least **two evenings a month** UNLESS A CLASS or OTHER EVENT IS HELD. So, please check the events page on the website to avoid disappointment. Only those people who email to register for a spot will be guaranteed a place. To register, go to the events on the website. Click on the crop session date you want to register for and email the person who is listed for that date. All the staff who man the crop sessions have a family with children, so if no one is registered for a crop session, we reserve the right to cancel it without notice. So it's a good idea to register.
2. **Price of a crop session** - \$60.00 for up to three hours. This is a flat fee regardless of what time someone shows up or how long someone stays. Sometimes, the host of a crop session is willing to stay longer if their schedule permits. This is entirely up to the host's schedule and those attending the crop session. For each additional hour the price is \$50.00/hr even if you only stay an additional 15 minutes so please be mindful of your time.
3. Right now, crop sessions are all held at the **Discovery Bay shop at 15E Sunrise Court.**
