Cheer Tumbling lvls 3&4		Students must be able to execute a back handspring with a minimum one hand spot. Students in this class will work on more advanced level tumbling skills such as back handspring series; back tuck; punch front;
Cheer Stunt & Strength Training		Cheer Stunt & Strength Training is specifically catered to cheer athletes to assist them with achieving the physically demanding skills required in Cheerleading. At the senior campus this includes exercises and drills to assist with tumbling, jumps and stunt work predominantly

Prerequisite Classes

Some classes require a high and varied level of skills that may not be possible to obtain in a single class. Ballet exam, comp troupe and cheer squad all have prerequisite classes which will help students reach the high levels required. The classes listed below are the minimum number of classes required. When training for advanced level things such as exams and comps, we encourage students to take as many classes as time and budget allows. This will ensure their strength, stamina and dance technique is as high as possible.
