We have witnessed dramatic market losses, declining property values, the fall of the integrity of the banking system, the upset of Wall Street and one of the highest percentages of unemployment. Every day seems to bring another piece of economic uncertainty.

A recent survey found that over three in four Americans are stressed about the economy and their personal finances. Half were worried about providing for their family's basic needs. Over half of reported feeling angry and irritable, and reported laying awake at night worried about this. The report concludes that, "The declining state of the nation's economy is taking a physical and emotional toll on people nationwide."

All of us have struggled with these issues at one time or another. They are important issues that we cannot ignore. Therefore, you will not want to miss the next several weeks at CBC as we as a church family take these topics head in a church-wide study and a sermon series entitled, "Enough: Discovering Joy Through Simplicity and Generosity." During this time we will explore what the Bible teaches us about financial management through corporate worship and our Life Fellowship studies.

What better way to begin the new year than by taking a financial inventory through a Biblical lens. Together may we find a sense of control, of balance, a sense of joy through simplicity and generosity.
