Drinking Water in the News - AQUA Act Will

"Ensure a reliable supply of drinking water for years to come."

-Chairman Edward J. Markey, Committee on Energy & Commerce

On May 26, 2010, the Committee on Energy & Commerce approved the AQUA Act, which will amend the Safe Drinking Water Act.

According to the publication released by the Committee, the Act will *"increase assistance to states, water systems, and disadvantaged communities, strengthen the Environmental Protection Agency's enforcement authority, encourage good financial and environmental management of water systems, reduce lead in drinking water, and strengthen the Endocrine Disruptor Screening Program."*
