## Japan's Quake Rippled Through Florida Groundwater

We are deeply saddened by the events in Japan, and we send our deepest sympathies and condolences to those who experienced and are still experiencing this tragedy.

We came across an article indicating that the quake was so strong that it appeared to have affected changes in Florida's groundwater:


About 30 minutes after the earthquake in Japan on March 11, the South Florida Water Management District recorded unusual activity by using groundwater guages. Sources say the water level fluctuated about three inches over a two-hour period.

The ripples of water were recorded by guages placed between 400 and 2,000 feet underground into the Floridan Aquifer. These guagues are typically used by the water management district to monitor regional water resources. To read the complete article, [Click Here](#).
