## 3 Reasons to Always Hire a Licensed Technician



Now that it's getting colder and you may find yourself without heat or hot water, you'll need to hire a technician to work in your home. Perhaps you are leaving for the winter, and you are looking to hire a technician to check in on your home, and provide repairs as needed.

When you reach for the phone, remember to ask for the technician's credentials. Is the technician licensed? **If a technician is unlicensed, you may be opening yourself to more problems than you've bargained for.** Here's why:

**1) If an unlicensed contractor is injured on your property, you could be sued.** There are safe guards in place when you choose to hire a *licensed* technician. Licensed technicians are accountable to the state. This means they are required to have insurances that protect your home and your assets if something were to go wrong while they are on the job. Licensed technicians carry Liability Insurance, Workers Compensation, Automobile Insurance, and the benefit of Third Party Mediation.

**2) Unlicensed technicians can cause considerable damage to your home, which may affect your family's health.** Licensed technicians are required to continually attend classes and gain knowledge in an ever-changing industry. They have to work to maintain their licenses, which means they have valuable expertise in the field, and they are familiar with state regulations.

\*Remember, heating system installations involve explosive dangers of natural gas, the potentially fatal aspect of carbon monoxide from a furnace that does not exhaust properly, and the shocking problems that could arise from improper electrical work.

**3) Unlicensed technicians can cause damage to your home which affects your time, finances, and the ability to sell your home in the future.** In the future, you may discover that certain issues were not repaired correctly; or perhaps your heating system installation doesn't pass inspection when you are ready to sell your home. You will then spend more time and more money in order to hire a licensed technician to address the repairs. Licensed technicians have expertise that often comes with a guarantee, so you can often avoid having the need for someone to come back and correct the mistakes of others.

**1) Prevent a leak in the Spring:** Before the winter arrives, we recommend that you take the hose off of the sillcock outside your house. This will prevent it from freezing, and will decrease the chance that you'll have a leak when you want to use the hose next spring.

**2) Have Your Burner Serviced:** Annual burner services are crucial to maintaining the efficiency of your burner and the safety of your home. We encourage you to schedule your annual burner service as needed. Proper service and maintenance will help decrease the chances that you'll lose heat this winter. As always, remember to hire a licensed technician.

**3) Keep your home safe and secure with routine Home Checks:** Whether you're planning on leaving for the entire season, or perhaps just one week for a vacation, you might be interested in having your home checked while you're away.
