Local Homeowner's Experience with Dishonest Drilling Company Leads to Big Issues

What would you do if you found out the well drilling company you hired, lied to you and your neighbor?

We recently ran into this issue with one of our customers. What was an initial "No Water" call has now turned into a much deeper issue: their well casing stops at 15', with the bedrock beginning at 18' down.

This leaves a gap of 3' where the casing fails to meet the bedrock, letting in more than just groundwater. The pump, originally down at 75', is completely buried under sand and mud.

It turns out that our customers' well was never drilled 300' down like they were told.

Sulfur Smell in Your Water?

Nobody likes to take showers in water that smells like rotten eggs. This smell is typically caused by Hydrogen Sulfide gas. Small amounts of Hydrogen Sulfide are not a health concern, but are definitely an aesthetic issue.

Hydrogen Sulfide is a naturally occurring gas, and is a residual from the decomposition of organic matter. As water runs through veins underground, it picks up minerals as it passes through, carrying those minerals into your water supply.

You may notice that the sulfur smell is more prominent if you haven't used your water or opened up your home in a while. As you begin to use your water and run your faucets, new water will enter your well and will flush out the water that has been sitting in your well. Most commonly, the sulfur smell will lessen over time as you use your water.

If running the water in your home doesn't reduce or get rid of the sulfur smell, your well may be pulling directly from a vein containing Hydrogen Sulfide underground. This means that the sulfur smell will not go away unless a filter system is installed to aerate the water before it feeds into your pipes. We have literature for these systems here in our showroom, and we welcome you to stop by to learn more.

The good news is that sulfur is common and you are definitely not the only homeowner with this issue. The bad news is that it just smells awful.

Testing Your Water is Easy as 1,2,3... and 4!

Before you invite family and friends to your home this summer, why not test your water to be sure that what you're giving them is safe? By taking a few easy steps, you can find out what's in your water in less than one week!



Step 1: Stop by our showroom to pick up your free Water Test Kit. Each kit includes the bottles you'll need, the directions to pull your test, and a card that lists your testing options.


Step 2: Review the list of testing options and corresponding prices. Select your choice and fill out the information on the card. *Remember, all pricing is Lab Pricing only and we do not charge anything extra.*

Step 3: Pull the test! We recommend pulling your test from the bathroom faucet. Remember to take off the washer and use an alcohol swab to wipe down the faucet. After letting the water run per the directions in your kit, go ahead and fill up the sample bottles.

Step 4: Drop off your test kit at our showroom that same day. Remember, we can only accept samples Monday through Thursday until 3:30pm. Bacteria can die in 27-30 hours, so it's important to bring your test directly to our office. We'll check over your test to ensure that you have filled out the necessary information and pulled your water sample correctly.

Next: Let us do the rest! We typically receive results in about three business days, and will forward your results directly to you. If there are any concerns with your water quality, we will put together a customized analysis with recommended solutions.
