Wasting Water When it's Needed Most

You have most likely read somewhere or heard from us that the average American uses anywhere from 80-100 gallons of water per day. Did you know that **nearly 14% of that water is wasted**? We are constantly using water at a faster rate than it can be replenished naturally.

This year, fourteen southern states are experiencing a severe drought, in states from Arizona to

Florida. According to the New York Times, the drought of 2011 may be one of the worst in our Nation's history. Although the drought is not affecting us as severely in New England, we still must be made aware of our water usage.

Here's how you can help in a few small ways:

Hire a licensed technician to do the following in your home:

- Repair leaks in faucets, toilets, etc
- Install low volume and low-flow showerheads, toilets, and aerators on faucets
- Install high efficiency clothes washer and dishwasher

Change Your Water Behavior around your home:

- Take shorter showers
- Keep a pitcher of water in the fridge instead of running the tap
- Run the washing machine and dishwasher with full loads only

Change Your Water Behavior around your yard:

- Set the lawn mower to 3 inches. Longer grass allows for less evaporation and shades the roots from drying out as quickly
- Wash cars with soap and water from a bucket
- Use a broom and NOT a hose to clear debris from sidewalks
