2024-2025 Tuition and Fee Schedule

Registration Fee - Due at time of registration, must apply annually

All grades annually (K-12th) - \$150.00 or \$200.00 per family

Technology Fee – Due September 1

All grades annually (K-12th) - \$150 per student, \$250 max per family
(parent internet access to MySchoolWorx to view child's grades, discipline, etc.)

Yearbook Fee - \$45 per student (if you order it by the deadline)

Book / Supply Fee - Half of the book fee is due **August 1**, Balance due **September 1**

The book/supply fee will cover textbooks, standardized testing, special classes for elementary, t-shirt and shorts for PE and play time dress/field trips, student accident insurance, and sports accident insurance.

Kindergarten	\$ <u>350</u> (an additional \$ <u>50</u> graduation fee due by 2/1/2024)
Elementary (1 st -5 th)	\$ <u>475</u>
Middle School (6 th -8 th)	\$ <u>500</u>
High School (9 th -12 th)	\$ <u>600</u> (12 th gr. – additional \$ <u>150</u> graduation fee due by 2/1/2024)
High School Retreat	\$ <u>75</u> (Required for grades 9 th – 12 th)

***Tuition** - Annual or broken into 10 or 12 equal monthly payments due on the 1st of the month, starting either June 1 or August 1 and ending May 1

Early Learning (K-3 rd)	\$ <u>6,000</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>600</u> per month)
Upper Elementary (4 th -5 th)	\$ <u>5,750</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>575</u> per month)
Middle School (6 th -8 th)	\$ <u>5,750</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>575</u> per month)
High School (9 th -12 th)	\$ <u>6,500</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>650</u> per month)

Exceptional Student Education Program

All Grades (self-contained classrooms with teacher/aide) \$9,500 / yr. (or \$950 per month)

Scholarships

We accept the following scholarships:

- **AAA Scholarship** – income-based scholarship – www.AAAScholarships.org
- **Step Up for Students** – income-based scholarship – www.stepupforstudents.org
 - **Family Empowerment – Educational Options (FES-EO)**
 - **Family Empowerment – Unique Abilities (FES-UA)** - based on qualifying diagnoses including ASD/Asperger's syndrome, emotional, speech impairment, and hearing impairment. IEP not necessary, but needed if student has one.
 - **Florida Tax Credit (FTC)** – income-based scholarship.
 - **Hope Scholarship** – For students who have been bullied in public school.

Tutoring Available - \$20 per hour, up to two hours per week for 36 weeks

Daily Bus Transportation Rates - \$1,600 round-trip, \$850 1-way per child per year.
