## Diaper Changing Pad Rev. 1/2024

## **Sewing Directions**

- 1. Use one piece of Flannel or French Terry and one piece of Cotton.
- 2. Cut both pieces 18" wide and 22" 24" long, depending on best use of fabric.
- 3. Round corners for ease of sewing (sample corner below).
- 4. Place the right sides together. Sew around the edge using a 3/8" seam, leaving a small opening for turning.
- 5. Turn right side out.
- 6. Top stitch 1/8" to 1/4" from edge, closing opening with top stitching. Or hand close opening.

## **Serger Directions**

- 1. 3. Follow steps 1 3 above.
- 4. Place wrong sides together.
- 5. Serge around edges.
- 6. Tie off serger threads.

## Piecing

To make good use of scraps, <u>one side</u> of the Diaper Pad can be pieced. Cut two pieces of either the flannel or the cotton fabric 1/2 the width or length, plus seam allowances. Sew or surge middle seam. Press seam to side. Top stitch over folded seam. Continue with directions above.
