Receiving Blanket

Fabric: Cotton flannel

Cutting: Cut 30"X30" squares. If using a bolt of fabric, measure 30" In from one side (exclude selvage). Tear down the length of the fabric – one strip is 30" and the other is 10-12" wide. Cut the 30" strip into squares. Return the smaller strip to the warehouse. It can be used for bibs, changing pads or quilt backs.

A. Serger:

Start serging on a straight edge, trimming only a small amount of fabric from the edge and rounding the corners as you go.
Overlap the stitching about 1" and secure the threads.

B. Sewing machine:

Turn under $\frac{1}{4}$ " and then fold over another $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
Sew close to the folded edge.
Corners may be square or rounded.

Rolled seams may be used.
