## Receiving Blanket

## Fabric: Cotton flannel

Cutting: Cut $30^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ squares. If using a bolt of fabric, measure $30^{\prime \prime}$ In from one side (exclude selvage). Tear down the length of the fabric - one strip is $30^{\prime \prime}$ and the other is $10-12^{\prime \prime}$ wide. Cut the $30^{\prime \prime}$ strip into squares. Return the smaller strip to the warehouse. It can be used for bibs, changing pads or quilt backs.
A. Serger:

Start serging on a straight edge, trimming only a small amount of fabric from the edge and rounding the corners as you go.
Overlap the stitching about $1^{\prime \prime}$ and secure the threads.
B. Sewing machine:

Turn under $1 / 4$ " and then fold over another $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
Sew close to the folded edge.
Corners may be square or rounded.
Rolled seams may be used.
