Gown

Sewn with serger

Fabric= Cotton knit with 20% stretch [3 inch piece will stretch to 4 inches]

Front and back - solid color

Sleeves – may be print and/or jersey with less stretch

Ribbing may be the same as the body of the gown or may be contrasting color.

All fabrics should agree as to gender- no mixing blue with pink, purple or flowers

Cutting:

According to pattern:

Cut 1 Front, 1 Back, 2 sleeves

2 ½ inch Ribbing: cut 1 piece 10 inch for neck: 2 pieces 5 in. for sleeves:

1 piece 18 in. for bottom

Instructions:

- 1. Fold sleeve ribbing in half lengthwise. Stitch to bottom of sleeves stretching to fit
- 2. Stitch sleeves to the gown front. Stitch back to one sleeve. Fold neck ribbing in half lengthwise and stitch* to neck edge, stretching the ribbing to fit evenly.
- 3. Stitch remaining sleeve-back. Seam from neck ribbing to underarm.
- 4. Stitch one side seam from the sleeve ribbing to the bottom of the gown.
- 5. Fold hem ribbing in half lengthwise and stitch to bottom of gown, pulling the ribbing to fit.
- 6. Stitch remaining side seam. Secure all threads. Fig.3

Stitch back to both sleeves.

Stitch short ends of neck ribbing together to make a ring. Fold ribbing in half. Fig.1 Match seam of neck ribbing to center of back and distribute the ribbing evenly around the neck opening and sew. Fig. 2






