ODDS AND ENDS:

*What to do with those leftover bits of fabric? It seems almost criminal to throw away a decent sized piece. Here is a guide of sorts.

Flannel is first used for receiving blankets. Scraps are good for changing pads or quilt patchwork.

Woven or broadcloth is used for quilts, bibs, or changing pads. Also used for diaper shirts in the summer. Leftovers? Patchwork for quilts.

Knit is used for most garments. Leftovers can be used for washcloths. I also use small pieces for an applique on the front of gowns.
