English Language Arts and Social Studies (Ms. Moore-Conner):

<u>First Grade ELA</u>: - Students will learn how to: establish a purpose for reading (review); identify the topic of the text and explain the author's purpose; understand consonant blends (review); identify ending consonant blends; blend words; write a personal story; and identify nouns and verbs.

First Grade SS: - Students will understand how people use geographic tools to locate information on maps and globes.

<u>Second Grade ELA:</u>- Students will learn how to: identify the author's purpose within a story; blend words with consonant blend sounds; understand the writing process by writing a personal story; and identify verbs (past, present, and future).

<u>Second Grade SS</u>: - Students will identify the physical characteristics of a community.

Homework assignments are due each Friday. Each week, I will send home a homework assignment sheet to help keep you and your child on task with the weekly assignments. Also, please ensure that you child is studying the spelling words for the weekly, Friday quiz. This is a major assessment grade and I want to ensure that your child is successful. Math and Science (Mr. Ryan):

<u>First Grade Math</u>: Students will: read/write time to the nearest hour; identify coins and estimate amounts to the nearest dollar.

First Grade Science: Students will review how to observe, compare, describe, and sort components of soil by size, texture, and color.

<u>Second Grade Math</u>: Students will: read/write time to the nearest hour; identify coins and estimate amounts to the nearest dollar.

Second Grade Science: Students will review how to observe and describe rocks by shape, size, and texture.
