Summer School Registration

Online Registration for Summer School will take place on Tuesday, April 2. There will be two 2-week sessions, June 3-13 and June 17-27. You can sign up for one or two sessions. The sessions are Monday through Thursday, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.; no parent participation is required. We will take a maximum of 24 kids, first come, first served. Alumni who are 10 years old and older can come back as volunteers and help us out. The Summer School fee is \$230 per child/ per two-week session.

Tile Fundraiser

Our tile fundraiser will take place in May. Our board voted to keep the price the same as the last couple of years: \$50 per tile. More info will follow soon.

Expert Help or Advice Needed

We are working on several projects throughout the school and could use some recommendations or expert advice:

- -Does anyone know someone who specializes in gates, particularly the iron gates at the front of the school and leading into the Group 2 play yard? We are looking to have the old spring replaced on the front entry gate and a new spring installed on the play yard gate.
- -Does anyone have a recommendation for a reasonably priced "bugman"/exterminator? Pest control at a school is carefully regulated, so the company must be willing to work with a school and be very familiar with those policies and procedures.
- -Do we know anyone who has access to or expertise in the area of replacement doors? We are looking into the possibility of replacing some of our interior and exterior classroom doors with Dutch-style doors. However, they are extremely expensive, and we need several! Please let me know if you have any leads. We would even be willing to purchase second-hand doors if they were the correct size.
- -We are looking for a donation of a short bookshelf for Group 2's writing area and a larger, taller cabinet with doors for the toddler classroom. We are hoping to find something second-hand that is still in good shape.
