Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays (Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini-Easter"), which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word *Lenten*, which means "spring." This period of forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry.

In the early church, Lent was a time to prepare new converts for baptism. Throughout time, many Christians began practicing the spiritual disciplines as a means to grow in their relationship with God. Today, Lent has become a time in the life of the church where the faithful embrace the spiritual disciplines of repentance and fasting in preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection.

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024. This year, however, First United Methodist Church will join other United Methodist Churches in the parish for a combined worship service at North View UMC at 7:00PM. It is my hope that during this season we might refocus and realign ourselves in relationship to God and one another as we embrace a penitential spirit. What better way to accomplish this endeavor than to join with other Christians as we begin this Lenten Journey.

Those of you who have known me for years know that I am not at all bashful in asking for help! So, I’m asking...



February is Open Heart Ministry Month

Join us on **February 11, 2024** as First United Methodist Church takes the opportunity to “remember and honor those we have served and those that make it possible” through our Parish and Community wide ministry, Open Heart Ministries.

A story shared by Diana Higginbotham, OHM Volunteer

Can you imagine, being a young mother with two active toddlers, and experiencing a bad fall resulting in a fractured patella? And then your husband gets laid off the same week. This young couple was referred to us needing help with a water bill and rent. The mother shared her story, telling me she had been hobbling around in a long-leg brace for about a month' the doctor had restricted her activity, so she could not work either. The only income was \$400 unemployment her husband was drawing & food stamps. The day we talked, the mother cried telling me that she had been to see the doctor and learned she would need surgery. Their water was shut off, and they were unable to pay the full months rent. Quickly we were able, with two partner churches, to get the water bill paid. No one can manage small children without water. One of our member churches took up a Sunday “love offering” to pay their rent. At OHM we are encountering many situations in which the requester is facing a utility shut off or eviction. We thank God, and thank you when you step up to help us, help those in such situations.

Open Heart has been serving Harrison County since 2007.
