           v 1                After six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, John up into a mountain.  
                               They see other O.T. prophets transfigured or in a bodily change.  
                               They are covered in a cloud.  
                               A voice from heaven speaks.
- E. Lk. 10:30-37      Parable of the Good Samaritan.  
                               Samaritan gives the man to the innkeeper and gives him two pence to  
                               care for him until his return.  
                               Mtt. 20:2 – one pence = one day's wages  
   two pence could be two days' wages  
                               Jesus coming two days after He left or 2,000 years
- F. Joshua 6:3-16      After six days – shout and the building walls fall, and the enemy is  
                               subdued.  
                               1 Thess. 4:16
- G. Jn. 1 & 2            Jesus went into Galilee for the wedding feast of Cana – after six days.  
                               1<sup>st</sup> day – Jn. 1:22-29  
                               2<sup>nd</sup> day – Jn. 1:29  
                               3<sup>rd</sup> day – Jn. 1:35  
                               4<sup>th</sup> day – Jn. 1:43  
                               Then Jn. 2:1 – the 3<sup>rd</sup> day was the wedding feast. It was the 3<sup>rd</sup> day after  
                               the 4 days in chapter 1, so it was in the 7<sup>th</sup> day the feast took place or  
                               after 6 days.
