INTRO

Genesis 1; Hebrews 11

I. Faith Speaking Spirit Beings.

- A. Genesis 1:3,6,9,11,14,20,24,26,28,29.
1. Notice "God said" is mentioned ten times in the first chapter.
 2. The first thing revealed about God is God speaks and it comes to pass.
- B. Hebrews 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God so that things which are seen were not made of things which also appear.
1. The Bible says faith framed the worlds.
 2. The Bible says things, which are seen, were not made of things which do appear. It is the unseen shaping the seen.
 3. The Bible describes all those times God said as faith. That was God's faith speaking.
- C. Mark 11:22-23 Faith is associated with words that are spoken. Have faith in God (Have the faith of God). For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
- What is the faith of God?
 - The faith of God is associated with believing and speaking words.
 - At some time in your life you will need a miracle from God. It may be for yourself or a loved one. No doubt you have found yourself in that position. You may be in great need today with sickness, finances, or some unseen power tormenting you. You can have a miracle. The Bible records many miracles. Some have thought the age of miracles is over, but the day of miracles is not over because there is still a God of miracles. He is the Lord God and He changes not. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
 - Where is that miracle you need so desperately? How can you get it? Where can it be found? Is it far or is it near?
 - There is a miracle in your mouth. There is a law in the Bible that says what you believe and speak can change things in you life. Your miracle is not far from you, it is near.
- D. Romans 10:8 But what saith it? The word is nigh thee even in thy mouth and in thy heart: that is the word of faith which we preach.
- v. 9 That is thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus and shall believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
- v. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- If you want a miracle start believing and speaking God's Word and God's will for your life.
 - What is the greatest miracle anyone can receive? Salvation.
 - How did the miracle of salvation come into their life? Believing and speaking.
 - If it will bring the greatest miracle, it will bring every other miracle.
 - The hinge that opens the door to the greatest miracle was the hinge of faith, which is believing and speaking.
 - We do not have to go to Heaven to get salvation, healing, or deliverance. We do not have to send away for it, it is nigh thee.
 - "But I cannot do such a thing." You were made and created to do it. Remember Genesis 1 God said...
- E. Genesis 1:26 says Let us make man in our image- resemblance; representative; figure; after our likeness; fashion; like us; manner; model; shape; similitude and let them have dominion...
- v. 27 So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them.

- What is the dominant image and likeness we see in chapter one of Genesis?
 - Yes, God is a spirit - Man is a spirit.
 - Yes, God is a trinity-Father, Son, Holy Spirit - Man is a trinity, spirit, soul, and body.
 - God is a speaking spirit.
 - God is a faith God.
 - God is a faith speaking Spirit being.
 - Let us make man after our image and likeness, a faith speaking spirit being.
 - Was it really the intent of God? Yes, in the New Testament look at the new creation.
- F. 2 Corinthians 5:17 If any man is in Christ he is a new creation. It is said of this new creation in 2 Corinthians 4:13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak.
- I am just like my Heavenly Father. I am a faith speaking spirit being.
 - We do not have to suffer in silence.
 - Isaiah 53:7 As a lamb to slaughter, as a sheep before his shearers is dumb, He opened not His mouth.
 - Why did He suffer in silence? This is the great redemption substitution chapter. He suffered in silence so we can boldly say Hebrews 13:5,6.

II. Words, Words, Words.

- There are millions of words in the world written in books, newspapers, magazines, and thousands of other places. They are just words.
- Then there are words written in the Bible. Thousands of them are in this miracle Book. Some of them look like all the other words in the world. They are spelled the same, sound the same, but **THEY ARE DIFFERENT.**
- John 6:63 Jesus said, The words I speak unto you are spirit and life.
- Proverbs 4:20-21 They are life to those that find them, medicine to all their flesh.
- Hebrews 4:12 The Word is alive, powerful, sharper then any two edged sword.
- 1 Peter 1:25 They will endure forever.
- Matthew 24:35 They will not pass away like Heaven and earth.
- Psalm 119:89 They are forever settled in Heaven.
- Isaiah 55:11 They will not return to God void and they will accomplish that which I please.
- Psalm 119:105,130 They are light to my path and lamp to my feet.
- John 17 They are truth - reality.
- 2 Timothy 3:16,17 They are inspired, God breathed.
- Though the words in the Bible may look like all others there is a difference. They are God's words. God has breathed life into them.
- When we take these God breathed words and believe and confess them miracles come to pass.

III. God Sent His Word for a Purpose.

- A. Isaiah 55:10,11 Maketh the earth to bring forth and bud. Makes it to do something it could not have done on its own.
- v.11 So shall My word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: It shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.
1. Everything God said in His Word is for a purpose.
 2. God's Word will not return to Him void, but it will:
 - a. Accomplish.
 - b. Prosper.
 3. That Word had to first go forth out of His mouth.
 4. If God's Word did not accomplish or prosper until it went out of His mouth, how will it work any different for us?
- B. Matthew 12:34-37 We all live under the influence of a word system.
- v. 34 O generation of vipers, how can ye being evil speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

v. 35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things; and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

v. 36 But I say unto you That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

v. 37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shall be condemned.

1. We all live under the influence of words and a word system of things.

2. No man or woman can choose if they live under the influence of words.

3. They can choose what kind of influence or effect those words have. Death and life are in the power of the tongue and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

4. We all eat the fruit of our words.

- God is looking for some people of faith in our generation.

1. No word - No faith - No stand because we Stand by faith Romans 11:20. We fall by unbelief Hebrews 4:11.

2. No faith - No Anointing. No anointing means burdens and yokes remain from generation to generation. The devil gets embedded in a generation and curses get passed down. God wants embedded and pass blessings down.

C. Hebrews 4:12 For the Word of God is alive, and powerful, sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thought and intents of the heart. Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.

1. Notice it says "his" not its sight. The Word is alive, it is powerful, it is sharper. You would think it would say, "not manifest in its sight" but it does not.

2. There is not anything God does not see.

3. There is not anything the Word does not cover - 100% coverage.
