

HEALING: SEVEN THINGS TO REMEMBER

- 1. Settle this fact – it is God’s will to heal you.**
The same Bible that says He forgives all our iniquities also says that He heals all our diseases Psalm 103:3.
- 2. Sickness and disease DO NOT come from God.**
Jesus went about doing good and healing all Acts 10:38. God does not need sickness and disease to teach you a lesson that is why He gave us His Word. All scripture (not sickness) is given... 2 Timothy 3:16,17.
- 3. Stay in the Word – hear and be healed.**
Why Romans 10:17? Faith to be healed comes by hearing and hearing by the Word. We are to live by the Word that proceeds from the mouth of God Matthew 4:4. "The proceeding word" not the "having heard" or "will hear" word. Do not substitute your belief in healing for the actual taking of God's medicine Proverbs 4:20-24. The devil will come to challenge your belief--fill your mind and spirit each day with healing scriptures.
- 4. See yourself well by meditating on the Word.**
See yourself having what the Word says is yours Psalm 1:1-3. Saturate your spirit and mind – put the Word in your eye gate, ear gate, and mouth gate concerning healing, and healing will begin from the inside out Joshua 1:8.
- 5. Remember FAITH is NOW.**
God is ready today Hebrew 11:1. He wants you to receive your healing today. Do not wait around saying, "Someday I am going to be healed." When it comes to receiving by faith – faith is now. We not only get whipped by the senses, but also the tenses.
- 6. Establish a release point for your faith.**
Establish a point of release in time when you say from now on I believe I have received Mark 11:24. A release point – it may be the day someone lays hands on you, anoints you with oil, or you just pray.
- 7. Do not talk defeat.**
Faith believes and speaks 2 Corinthians 4:13. Death and life are in the power of the tongue Proverbs 18:20,21. From the moment you release faith for healing, do not talk defeat, sickness or disease, or claim it as yours. Do not talk about how you feel, talk about what you believe--this is the fight of faith, and holding fast to your profession of faith.
