Midway's Profession of Faith Goal

Our goal for 2012 is to have at least five people join the church by first-time profession of faith in Christ.

SMART* Actions to reach that goal

1. The desire for new members, especially through profession of faith, will be a high priority in prayer. It will be one of the focuses of our Prayer Group.
2. The pastor will identify folks active in the congregation who are not members and personally invite them to consider membership at Midway UMC – by March 31.
3. We will regularly share – at least every two months – in church publications (bulletin and newsletter) how to join the church.

Far, far more than anything else, the one thing that brings people to church and to Christ is a personal invitation by a friend. Most folks will go to church if they are invited. And an invitation by a friend is much more effective than an invitation by a pastor. Pray, ask God to show you who you should invite to worship at Midway, then invite that person, and continue praying for him/her.
