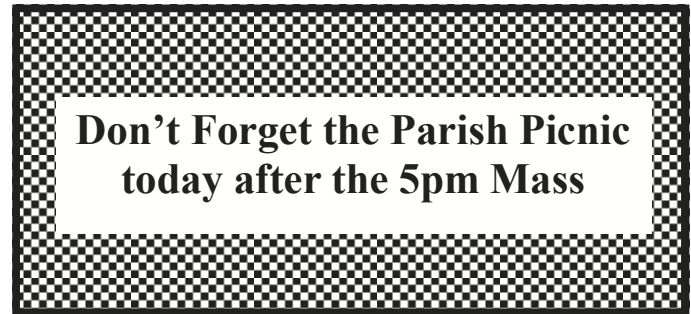


**Sunday June 21st is Fathers Day**
