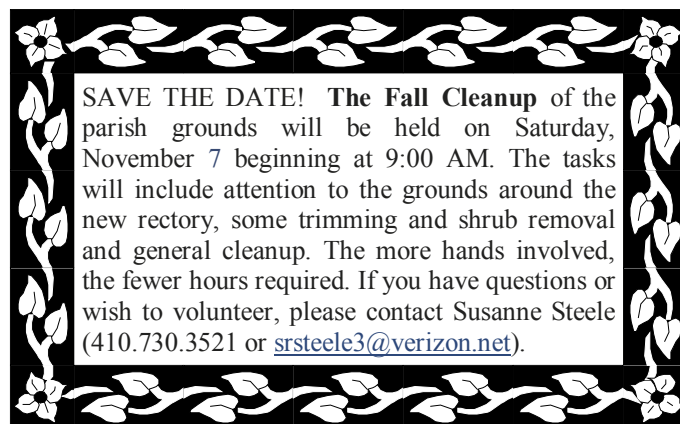

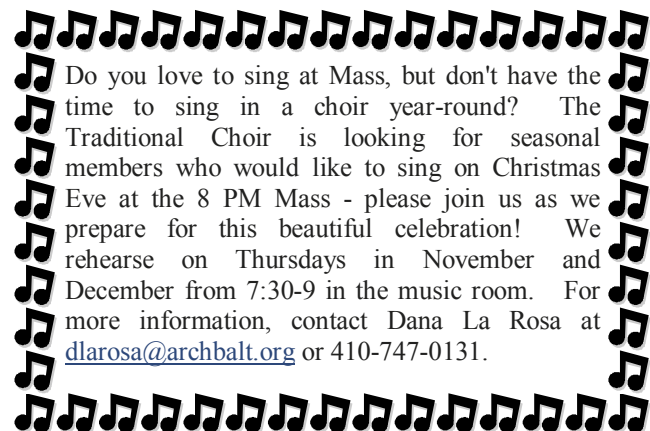
### Living Covenant in a Contract World A Scripture-based Valentine's Day Retreat for Married Couples
