Dear Parishioners,

I want to invite you to join us on Saturday, November 22, when we will gather together with Fr. Augustine and the parish community of St. Veronica's in Cherry Hill, our sister parish. They will be coming to celebrate the 4:30pm Mass with us, bringing their parish choir, and then we will enjoy a meal together in the parish center. Your generosity with the Lenten Appeal has had a significant impact on their Youth Ministry programs and Fr. Augustine would like to share with us some of the success stories from our sister parish relationship. ***Please see the sign-up sheets in the back of the church to let us know you will be coming so that we can prepare! This is a wonderful opportunity to foster a real relationship of friendship and love with our sister parish.***

I also want to give you an update on our sister parish in Haiti, *Our Lady of the Nativity*, and the good work that is happening there. Deacon Mortel, the Director of Missions for the Archdiocese, just sent this update for us: Your generosity with the Lenten Appeal is making possible a gift of \$23,500 which is being used to directly support the work of the feeding program of the school of 200 students from Grade 1 thru 6. An additional \$10,530 is being used to pay the salaries of teachers in their parish school this year. We were also able to offer \$3,970 for the formation of catechists, as well as for the purchase of books, material, and Bibles.

All of this good news is made possible by your generosity in the Lenten Appeal. Thank you to all of those who give so generously to make this good work possible!

VOCATION CHALICE PROGRAM

You are invited to participate in a new program here at OLPH. It is called the Vocation Chalice Program. Every other Sunday, a family, couple, or individual will be called forward at the end of Mass to receive the Vocation Chalice and special prayer book and instructions written to accompany it. In taking the chalice, they will commit themselves to pray for vocations during the week in the name of our parish in thanksgiving for all those generously sharing in Church ministry and, in particular, for the gift of sisters and brothers, priests, and deacons. All of you are invited to participate in this program. There is a sign up sheet in the back of the church. We encourage you to sign up for one of the weeks then to attend that Mass and receive the Vocation Chalice. It is our hope that this experience will encourage each of us to take seriously our vocation as a member of the Body of Christ and encourage ALL of us to pray for the gift of vocations to priesthood and the consecrated life (not just the family with the chalice for the week). We believe that the Holy Spirit is calling forth men and women from our faith community to these roles of service. May our prayer help to inspire young women and men to be attentive to the movement of the Spirit with them and to step forward in faith and with generous hearts to wherever the Holy Spirit lead them. 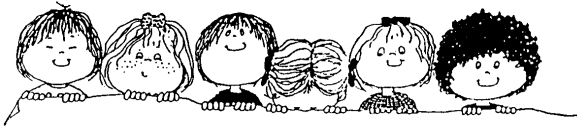
