

• **GUIDE FOR GIRLS / GRADES K-12<sup>TH</sup>**

Dress Code	Effective August 1, 2009
<b>Shirts</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>White, red, black, gray s/1 sleeved collared polo with school logo</b> (Uniform merchants will have the designated acceptable style numbers.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Skin should not be exposed when bending over, reaching up, or raising arms above the head.</li> <li>• No cleavage visible; bust-line and all undergarments should be covered</li> <li>• Fit properly – Not accenting the bust/bunlines or oversized and baggy</li> <li>• A long sleeved shirt may not be worn under an outer shirt with short sleeves.</li> <li>• Top button (only) may be unbuttoned.</li> <li>• <b><u>Forsyth Christian</u></b> shirts are no longer allowed</li> </ul>
<b>Skorts</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>School plaid/khaki skort purchased from school approved merchants.</b> (Uniform merchants will have the designated acceptable style numbers.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must fit properly at the waist and come no more than 3 inches above the knee.</li> </ul>
<b>Pants/Shorts</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Khaki or Black Dockers style slacks OR khaki (long) shorts</b> <b>purchased from the school approved merchants.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain blue jeans (no embellishments) may be worn on Fridays only.</li> <li>• Pants may not extend past the heel of the shoe. Shorts must be at least 3”below the fingertips.</li> <li>• Worn on the waist</li> <li>• A belt must be worn with all pants having belt loops. (Loops may not be removed to bypass this guideline.)</li> <li>• Vents may not be cut.</li> <li>• Cut off or frayed pants are not permitted</li> </ul>
<b>Belts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• brown/black leather belt</li> <li>• brown/black braided belt</li> <li>• khaki stretch belt</li> <li>• Belts may not have spikes or chains</li> </ul>
<b>Footwear</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Solid white or solid black athletic shoes</b> or <b>black or brown conservative shoes</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open toe/open heel shoes are not allowed including Birkenstocks, flip-flops, or sandals.</li> <li>• Boots, house slippers, and athletic shoes with “lights” are not permitted.</li> <li>• Heels – no more than 2” high</li> </ul>
<b>Socks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>K5-5<sup>th</sup></b> – solid white or black knee high socks/crew socks/tights, peds</li> <li>• <b>6<sup>th</sup> – 12</b> –solid white or black knee highs or tights, peds</li> <li>• <b>White athletic socks</b> may be worn <b>only with tennis shoes and must be visible above the shoes.</b></li> <li>• Leggings are not allowed.</li> <li>• Socks/hosiery must be worn with all shoes.</li> </ul>
<b>Hats</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hats should not be worn in the buildings at any time or at any school related event (dances, field trips, sporting events, etc.)</li> <li>• Hats must be taken off before entering the building and kept in the locker during the school day.</li> <li>• Administration reserves the right to grant permission to wear hats on a designated day or occasion.</li> </ul>

<b>Sweatshirts</b> <b>Sweaters</b> <b>Jackets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Classroom approved outerwear attire:</b> black, red, or gray cardigan or crew neck sweater with school logo (Must be purchased from school approved merchants.)</li> <li>• <b>FCS spirit wear sweatshirts</b> with or without the hoods may be worn at any time. Any sweater, sweatshirt, or jacket may be worn as outerwear but must be removed once inside and kept in the locker unless it meets the guidelines for classroom attire.</li> </ul>
<b>Hair</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Combed, neat</li> <li>• Plaid, khaki, black, white, or red headbands, scrunchies, and bows on a barrette are acceptable.</li> <li>• All hair accessories should coordinate with the uniform colors.</li> <li>• General appearance must not be a distraction.</li> </ul>
<b>Jewelry</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Earrings may be worn in the ears (only) and only 1 earring should be in each ear.</li> <li>• <i>"Body piercings"</i> should not be visible.</li> <li>• Earrings may not be longer than 1" or larger than a quarter in diameter.</li> </ul>
<b>Tattoos</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be completely covered at all times</li> </ul>
<b>P.E.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>K-5<sup>th</sup> grade:</b> School approved shorts/slacks and school approved collared shirt</li> <li>• <b>6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> :</b> P.E. uniform guidelines are given in course syllabus.</li> </ul>
<b>Jeans Day</b> (Fridays only)	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Plain blue jeans</b> (no embellishments)  White, red, black, gray s/l sleeved <b>collared polo</b> with school logo or <b>FCS spirit wear</b>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jeans with embellishments, holes, frays, patches, or worn out areas, are not permitted.</li> <li>• Fit around the waist</li> <li>• no clinging or form fitting pants (under-wear lines /underwear must not be visible)</li> <li>• Vents may not be cut.</li> <li>• Regular pant length must not be past the heel of the shoe.</li> <li>• Cutoffs, athletic style with an elastic waist, sweatpants/warm-ups, pajama wear, and spandex are not permitted.</li> </ul>
<b>Field Trip Attire</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Elementary:</b> s/l sleeved red polo with school logo and khaki shorts/slacks</li> <li>• <b>Middle/High:</b> s/l sleeved polo with school logo and khaki slacks</li> <li>• Administration may approve/require a different dress code as dictated by the nature of the field trip.</li> </ul>
<b>Special Functions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Modesty and neatness guidelines will be followed when special functions require a dress code deviation.</li> <li>• Administration must approve the dress code in advance and parents must be notified in writing.</li> </ul>
