The Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association is proud to be able to announce a Softball Clinic to be held in conjunction with our Annual Baseball Clinic--to be held at Washington High School, Cedar Rapids, Iowa on Friday and Saturday, March 9th and 10th, 1979.

This is the Eleventh Annual Baseball Clinic and will begin an outstanding series of Softball Clinics. The speakers and demonstrators are all nationally known Softball players and coaches. Please read their personal sketches in the accompanying brochure.

Our clinic will afford you an outstanding opportunity to discuss strategy, skills, drills etc with other knowledgeable Softball players and coaches. Your players will have an opportunity to see demonstrations of the individual skills of the game, get an opportunity to practice the skills under the supervision of guest participants and have an opportunity to personally discuss concerns with experts in the field of Softball. Please give the clinic serious consideration in your future plans.

REGISTRATION: Enclosed you will find a registration form. Admission to the Clinic will be \$17.50. This will include your membership, meals and clinic fee. If you have not registered by March 1, the clinic will cost you \$20.00. Make your check payable to the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association. We will order as many meals and noon lunches as we have paid reservations.

High School Students rates are \$5.00 for full clinic or \$3.00 per day. If they want to eat the meals, it will cost the student \$15.00.

CLINIC SPEAKER LINE-UP

TOM MACAREAVY: Basketball & Softball Coach at Prairie High School, Cedar Rapids, is known in the state for his numerous teams in the state tournament. He has taken his team to the State 9 times. Winning the State Championship 5 times and coming in second twice. Tom has been one of the outstanding Softball coaches in the state, with an overall record of 318 wins and 47 losses. He coached at Oxford, Clear Creek and Cedar Rapids Prairie over the past 20 years.

GREGG BOSCH: A left-handed pitcher, Gregg started pitching in 1968. Gregg started his career in Minnesota where he spent 4 years, moving on to South Dakota for 2 years. At South Dakota his teams won the State Championship. Gregg was elected the M.V.P. Pitcher. Gregg came to Cedar Rapids in 1975, playing in the Major Open and many tournaments throughout the Midwest. Some of his honors are: Four State Championships, been M.V.P. Pitcher three times in the State. All-Regional twine. Presently Gregg is teaching and coach at LaSalle High School.

BRUCE HOTCHKISS: Started his baseball career at Regis High School, from Regis Bruce went to Ellsworth Jr. College, entering the Pro's in 1967, with the Phillies organization. Bruce reached the Triple A Reading Club before he retired from Pro ball in 1971. Since that time he has played softball in the Cedar Rapids area, last year with Modern Piping who won the I.S.C. State and A.S.C. State. Played in the I.S.C. World Series Tournament and the A.S.C. Regional Tournament. Presently his is the General Manager of the Midwest Janitorial Service.

AL RAUCH: Softball & Basketball Coach at Kirkwood College started his playing career in Garnavillo High School. Al went from there to Minneapolis and played for a couple of years. His overall record is 190 wins and 45 losses. Al is one of the country's best softball clinicians, speaking at many clinics throughout the country. An example is the U.S. Olympic Committees Clinic and the A.S.A. softball clinic. He has received numerous awards over the years for his pitching. Al is a graduate of Iowa State University.

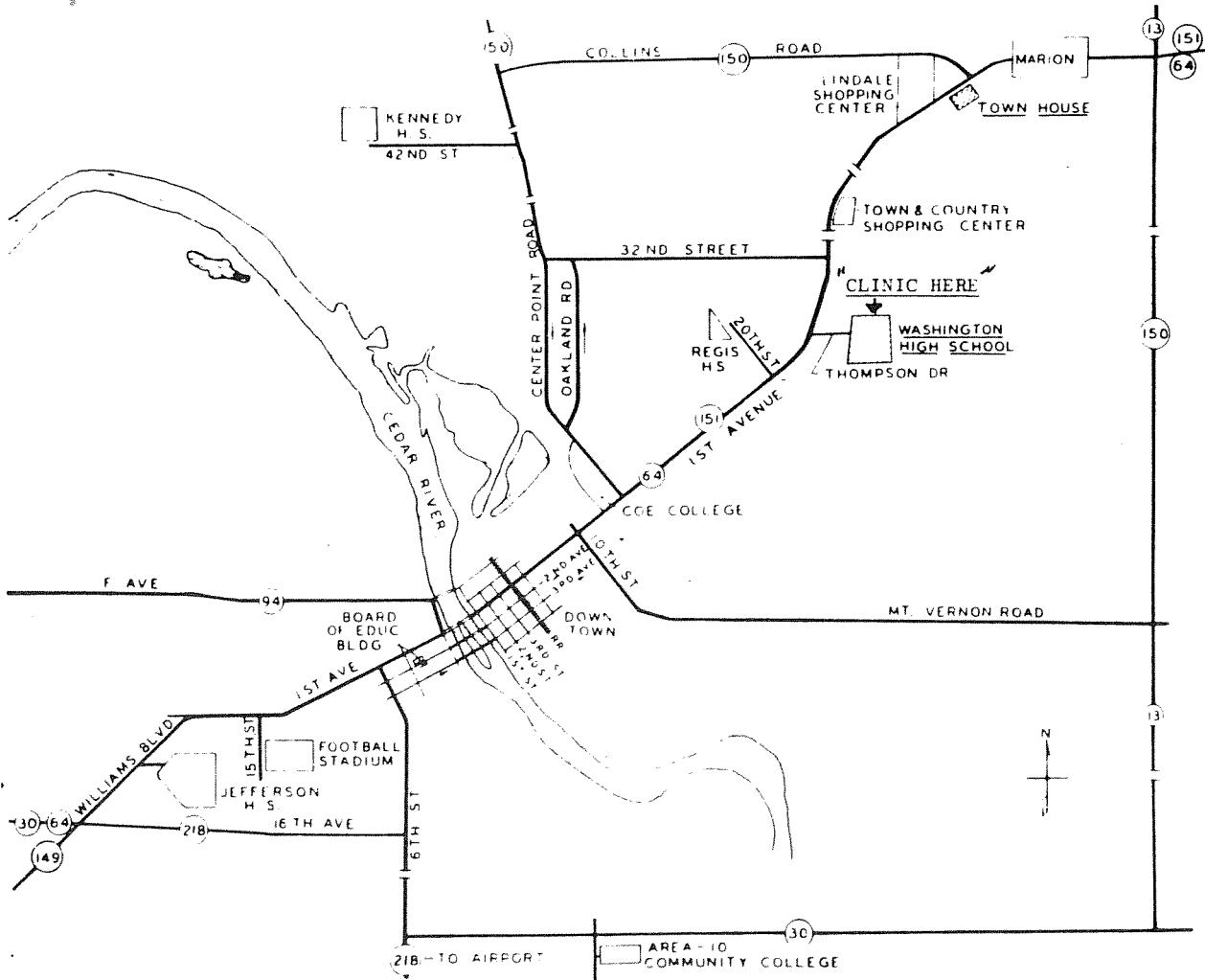
