October 1970 NEWSLETTER

We are getting new memberships and renewals in at a steady rate. If you find enclosed your membership card, you have paid your dues. If you did not find your 1971 membership card enclosed, send in your dues for renewal. This will be your last newsletter if you do not send in your dues.

We hope the organization has offered the baseball coaches who are members something for their money and also something with which they can improve their own baseball program. Get involved with the coaches organization and you will enjoy it and benefit from it.

Plans are under way to hold our annual baseball clinic. It will be held at Cedar Rapids Washington on Friday and Saturday, March 12 and 13. So far we have lined up Dennis Olejniczak, Decorah Summer Champs; Bill Freese, Davenport Central Spring Champs; Dr. Joe Dolan, Head of P. E. at Northwest Missouri State; Bob Oldis, Scout for Montreal Expos; Gene Baker; Scout for Pirates; John Kleipstein, Scout for Detroit. (The last three are former big league ball players.)

At the clinic we are planning to honor five great baseball men. They will be inducted into the Hall of Fame. Make your plans to attend and honor these men. Their names will be announced at a later date. At the same time we will honor the five district coaches of the year and pick one for the IHSBCA Coach of the Year. These men will be chosen at the Board meeting held at Ames, October 17. The coaches nominated them on the baseball ballot for All-District teams.

Jack Ogden of the Cedar Rapids Gazette and Tait Cummins of WMT-TV will help with our news releases and publicity this year. They have served us in this capacity since the organization started.

Article VI, Section 2 of your Constitution (enclosed) requires the Board members of your district to send out election and nomination ballots. To save time and money, you will find enclosed a nomination ballot for the Board of Directors. Send your nomination ballot to the person underlined on your ballot. YOU MUST RETURN IT BY OCTOBER 26--ten days from mailing. Check April's newsletter for names of members in your district.

The next Executive Committee meeting will be Saturday, October 17 at 10:00 a.m. at Beyer Hall at Iowa State in Ames. Anyone is welcome to attend.

Enclosed you will find a map of the five districts in Iowa. Take a good look at the map and see if your district is holding up its share of promoting baseball in Iowa. We need your support throughout Iowa in order to hold a top-notch clinic as we have had the past two years. A break down of 1969070 members is included on the map.

In next month's newsletter I will list the members and schools who have joined for the 1970-71 season. Also next month's news will include the results of the nomination and the new candidates for the new board.

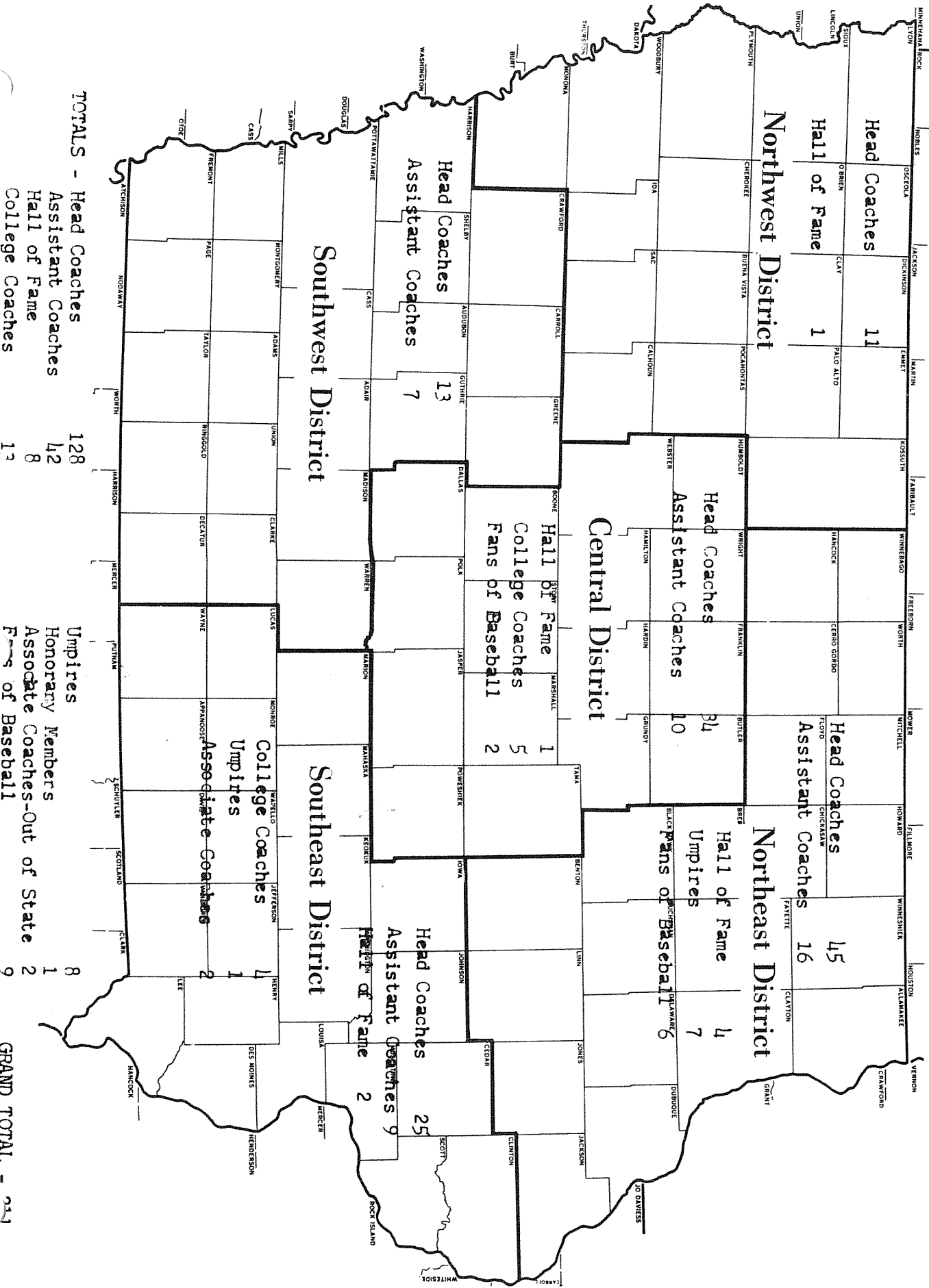
On the back of the nomination ballot is a questionnaire which you should fill out so we can receive it with your nominations. The results will be tabulated and released in a later newsletter. We hope some of the coaches throughout Iowa can win a pay raise because of some of the samples of other schools pay scales. Also we hope we can improve baseball by having some of the fundamentals of the game around--scoreboards, outfield fences, dugouts, pitching mounds for pitchers to warm up on, and batting cages.

A couple of leagues have sent in the results of their seasons. If you have your results, send them in.

There have been over 148 coaching changes in baseball in Iowa since last year. Some are new coaches and others have changed locations. We hope the new members will join the coaches association. The association can offer many helpful tips and suggestions plus the clinic that is sponsored by the association. You will find listed the names of the new coaches in their new coaching job. Twenty-nine schools have not named their baseball coach as of the October directory. This could mean a total of 177 coaching changes in baseball over the past year.
