200 WIN CLUB: All coaches who have won over 200 games please send in your name and your record to the Executive Secretary. We would like to print the names of those coaches who have achieved 200 wins. We will have a 300 win, a 400 win, and a 500 and over win club. Coaches will receive a certificate for this accomplishment at the Seventh Annual Clinic March 14-15, 1975.

BASIC SLIDING RULES: 1. Once you decide to slide, go through with it. Never change your mind.

- 2. Make your slide with speed
- 3. Remember, it is a slide and not a leap
- 4. Learn to fall in a relaxed manner.
- 5. For the straight-in slide, concentrate on watching the base.
- Hook slide, concentrate mainly on the hands of the fielder.
- 7. On all force plays, employ bent leg slide.
- 8. Clench your hands loosely when sliding, to avoid broken fingers. Stay relaxed.

These sliding rules come from Alston and Weiskopf baseball handbook. An excellent book.

TO ALL IOWA HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL COACHES:

This letter is to introduce our association to all new high school baseball coaches and to encourage all previous member coaches to continue their affiliation.

This marks the 8th school year that the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association has been in existence and the 7th year that a baseball clinic will be held in the spring of 1975.

We hope that you as a high school baseball coach will take an active interest in your coaches organization. The dues of \$5.00 is relatively small in comparison to the benefits received. The great fellowship with other coaches is alone worth more than the membership dues.

It goes without saying that the IHSBCA is the most dynamic of all coaching groups in the State of Iowa. We have many coaches to thank for this including our executive secretary, Pinky Primrose, who has been the greatest promoter of our association as well as the editor of the bi-monthly newsletter.

Our organization's accomplishments have been many. Each year, three all-district teams are selected from the five districts. The Coach-of-the-Year awards are given annually to the high school, junior college, and 4-year college coach who have made outstanding contributions to Iowa baseball. The Baseball Hall of Fame was created for the first time in Iowa and new members are inducted annually. Active coaches are also recognized each year for winning 200 or more games.

This year, the IHSBCA added a new dimension to Iowa baseball when, at its urging, the Des Moines Register started the ratings poll. Not only did this create considerable interest across the state, but the poll itself proved to be quite accurate since seven of the eight eventual tournament finalists were in the top five of their respective classes. This can be attributed to the weekly recommendations of our member coaches who participated in the ratings poll.

The result of this added interest created the selection of  $\Lambda$ 11-State teams by the Register for the first time. Those players selected were picked from the  $\Lambda$ 11-District lists submitted by the IHSBCA.


The highlight of every year is the annual spring clinic which has been a very useful teaching tool in helping both coaches and their players. I can authentically say that this helped my own team when my knuckleball pitcher Russ Larson came to the 1972 clinic on his own and met with Dutch Leonard who helped and encouraged him with his knuckleball. This resulted in a state tournament berth for Burlington in 1974 and a college scholarship and all-state honors for Russ. No doubt, we at Burlington are sold on the annual IHSBCA spring clinic.

We hope that you will strongly consider joining the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association now! What better way can you show your players and community that you are truly interested in baseball and in improving your coaching skills? Your membership to the IHSBCA will not only benefit you, but it will be a solid boost for high school baseball in Iowa.

#### Pitcher:

Go half way between home and 3rd and then back up the base where throw is going.

# Catcher:

Protect home plate.

#### 1st Baseman:

Be the cut-off man.

# 2nd Baseman:

Trail about 30 feet behind shortstop in line with 3rd base.

# Shortstop:

Go to a spot in left center to become relay man.

#### 3rd Baseman:

Cover 3rd base; stand on left side of base.


# Center Fielder:

Back up the left fielder.

# Right Fielder:

Move in to cover 2nd base.

#### NOMINATION BALLOT FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 2. Board of Directors. (A) The representatives to the Board of Directors shall be elected by the members within their district. By October 15 of each year, the association members will receive an official blank nomination ballot. Upon voting, the nomination ballot to be returned (within ten days from mailing) to the executive secretary. In the presence of two other association members, there shall be a canvass of the ballots. The 3 receiving the highest number of votes shall be considered the nominees. In case of a tie of more than 3, all those in the ties shall be considered nominees. In case the number of nomination ballots for any one of the nominees is a majority of the number of members in the respective district, he shall be declared elected. The executive secretary shall prepare and mail official election ballots to the members of the district. Upon voting, the election ballot to be returned (within ten days from mailing) to the executive secretary. The procedure in canvassing shall be the same as in canvassing nomination ballots and the person receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected. In case of a tie, the election shall be decided by lot by the candidates in the presence of the canvassing committee. The third highest vote getter shall be considered the alternate and in event of inability of elected Director to serve alternate will be appointed to the Board of Directors.


