This is down from the 1973-74 season when 166 coaches left the profession. The Northwest District again leads the parade with 35 new coaching positions. This is down from the previous year when 44 coaches left the North west District. The Northeast District is second with 32 changes.

Dear Coaches:

Looking forward to all you coaches to join the coaches association and coming to the 8th Annual Clinic.

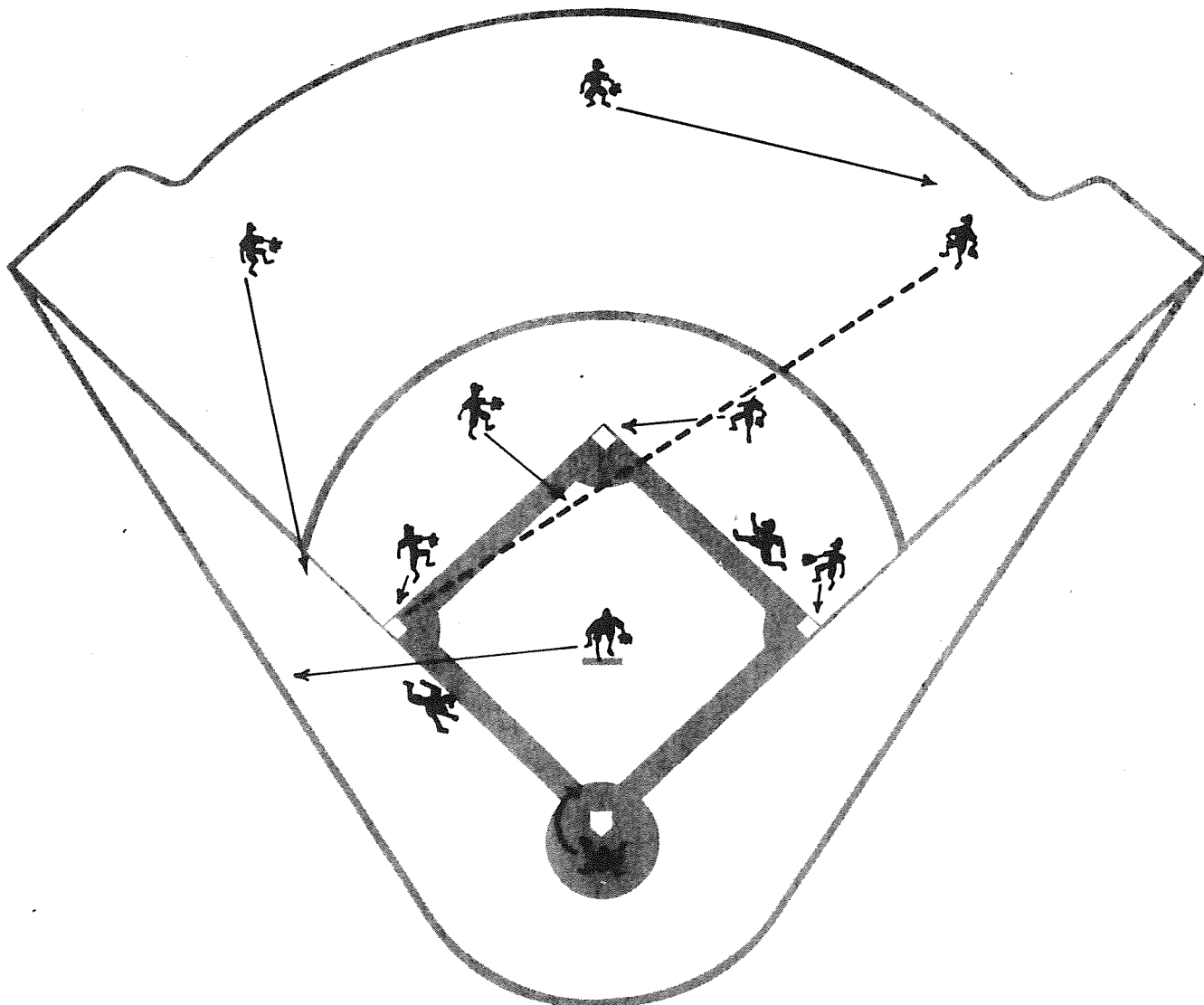
