Additional Allocations

Care for Kids - \$3,000 - Funds to allow district pupil service staff to address requests for special individual needs; i.e., coats for kids.

Exchange City Program - \$1,500- Funds to cover fees for any fifth grade student on free and reduced lunch

Stonehenge Awards - \$2,000 - A unique program of support and positive re-enforcement for students enrolled in the district's special education program.

Presidential Community Service Scholarship - \$1.000 - Two matching \$500 scholarships for selected students.
