BUILDING ON THE WORD

The 32nd Psalm (Part 1)

The Blessing of Forgiveness

David declares the blessing of forgiveness. This beatitude is the heart of this psalm, so we will spend a large bulk of our time in these first two verses.

Double Blessing

The word **"blessed"** (32:1) stands out because Psalms 1 and 2, the introduction to the Psalms, begin and end with this same word. In fact, this is the first time this word **"blessed"** has been used since the first line of the book of Psalms.

There is an important difference though. Psalm 1 declares the blessings of the ideal man who never sins or stands with sinners.

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers. (Psalm 1:1)

This blessing is for someone who constantly walks in God's way, which none of us do. In fact, Psalm 1:1 indicates that this man is never involved with anything tainted by evil. The man of Psalm 1 is the perfect man, Jesus Christ. But Psalm 32 declares the blessing of a man who is far from perfect. This man does sin, and God forgives him.

Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit. (32: 1, 2)

David declares a double blessing on those whom God forgives. To emphasize the blessing of forgiveness, David repeats the beatitude in verse 2. What better way to encourage you and me to confess our sins than a double promise of blessing?

This blessing is even more attractive and tempting because a good translation for the word **"blessed"** is **"happy."** So we could translate verses 1, 2, ***"How happy is the one whose transgression is forgiven How happy is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity."*** This is the joy of knowing that God is for you, that he is kind and forgiving. Everyone wants to be blessed; everyone wants happiness. How happy and blessed are the forgiven!

Medical News: Breast Cancer Awareness Week

What are the different types of breast cancer? Where does breast cancer come from?

There are many types of breast cancer. Some are more common than others, and there are also combinations of cancers. Some of the most common types of cancer are as follows:

- Ductal carcinoma in situ:** The most common type of non-invasive breast cancer is ductal carcinoma in situ (DCIS). This early-stage breast cancer has not spread and therefore usually has a very high cure rate.
- Invasive ductal carcinoma:** This cancer starts in the milk ducts of the breast and grows into other parts of the surrounding tissue. It is the most common form of breast cancer. About 80% of invasive breast cancers are invasive ductal carcinoma.
- Invasive lobular carcinoma:** This breast cancer starts in the milk-producing glands of the breast. Approximately 10% of invasive breast cancers are invasive lobular carcinoma.
- The remainder of breast cancers is much less common and includes the following:**
- Mucinous carcinoma** is formed from mucus-producing cancer cells. **Mixed tumors** contain a variety of cell types.
- Medullary carcinoma** is an infiltrating breast cancer that presents with well-defined boundaries between the cancerous and noncancerous tissue.
- Inflammatory breast cancer:** This cancer makes the skin of the breast appear red and feel warm (giving it the appearance of an infection). These changes are due to the blockage of lymph vessels by cancer cells.
