

Launch — **Read Judges 7:16-25.** Discuss the interesting aspects of God calling Gideon to lead the people in battle. What does this battle tell us about God? About the Church?

- The bible is filled with battle scenes and battle preparations. Read the following Scriptures and discuss the difference between the battle we face alone or with God.
- Ephesians 6:10-13
- 2 Corinthians 10:4-5

Explore – Discuss the following outline regarding Gideon's battle.

1. Strange Preparations (v. 16)

- Trumpets, pitchers, and torches.
 - 1. Those who have faith in God can afford to use weak things (according to the world).
 - 2. Compare the weapons of David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17:40-45)
- Testimony, Life, The Light of God.
 - 1. The trumpet compares to our testimony we have in Christ.
 - 2. The pitcher is a picture of our lives emptied out before God...
 - 3. The torch is the light of God that fills our lives
 - 4. When we go into battle emptied of self and filled with God, we cannot lose.

2. Present Example (v. 17)

- Gideon was an example to the people.
- We have a privilege of being an example to others.

3. Uniting Battle Cry (v. 20)

- Notice, the only sword they had was the "Sword of the Lord!" → The word of God!
- The Word of God is mightier than any other weapon of our spiritual battle.

4. Complete Victory (v. 21)

Apply – What battles are you facing right now? What Scripture can you use in your life to combat against your battle?

Prayer – Ask God to help you fight with the "Sword of the Lord."
