Introduction:

- Francois Fenelon Happy is the man who gives himself to God. He is delivered from his passions, from the judgments of men, from their malice, from the tyranny of their sayings, from their cold and wretched mocking, from the wiles and snares of enemies, from our own weakness, from misery and the brevity of life, from the horrors of death, and in the end, from the eternal condemnation of God. He is delivered from this countless mass of evils, because placing his will entirely in the hands of God, He wants only what God wants.
