

Crocheted Booties



Materials: Size E crochet hook and baby yarn

Leg: Ch 21. Join with slip stitch. Sc in each ch around. Work sc in each sc around for 6 rows.

Toe: Ch 11. Turn and work sc in second and in each ch - work around leg and up opposite side of chain to end of toe (40 stitches) Ch 1, turn.

Working in back loop only, work sc for 6 rows around toe and leg.

Sc in next 18 sc; at heel, decrease 1 on next two sc twice; sc in next 18 sc; ch 1 and turn.

Sc in next 17 sc; decrease 1 on next two sc twice; sc in next 17 sc; ch 1 and turn.

Sc in next 16 sc, decrease 1 on next two sc twice; sc in next 16 sc.

Turn inside out and slipstitch to close bottom of foot.

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EASY CROCHET BOOTIES

3 ply baby yarn, F hook for preemie, F for newborn.

Always work beginning stitch in same st. as turning ch.

Abbreviations: Triple crochet - tr, double - dbl, single - sc, chain - ch,
decrease - dec

Ch. 12 for beginning of sole

1 - Triple in third chain from hook 3 times, tr 1 in each ch
to end, 8 tr in end ch. - working along opposite side of ch - tr in
each st. to end, work 3 tr in end ch. Join, ch 1

2 - single crochet in back loops around, join, ch 1

3 - sc around, join, ch 1

4- sc in next 5, decrease 9 times 9 working over next 18 sts.) sc to to end,
join, ch 1

5 - sc around, dec 1 at toe, join, ch 3

6 - ch 3, ch forms first post of this round - ribbon will be woven through this
round. (ch 2, skip 1, double in next st.) around. There should be 9 post
counting ch 3. (If you don't come out exactly right on your count, then just
even it out so you get 9 post - make sure both booties have the same amount)
Join, ch 3

Shell Cuff (cuff can be ended off after row 1 or 2 depending on desired
height)

1 - make shell in top of first post (shell is made : 2 dbl, ch 1, 2 dbl) dbl in top
of next post,

shell in top of next post, dbl in top of next post repeat around. Join, you
should have

4 shells.

2 - ch 3, work shell in each shell, dbl in each dbl. Join

3 - ruffled edge : ch 3, sc in each st around, join, end off and work in tail.

Weave ribbon through row with post.

Mary Jane's Crochet Booties

#7 Crochet Hook – Coats and Clark Baby Yarn

Chain 21

ROUND 1

1 sc in 3rd ch from hook and in each of next 8 sts, 1 dc in each of next 9 sts, 4 dc in last at for toe. working opposite side of ch, work 1' dc in each of 9 sts, 1 sc in each of 9 sts, 3 sc in same st with 1st sc. (44 Sts)

ROUND 2

Ch 3, 1 dc in same st with slip st, 1 dc in each of next 18 sts, 2 dc in each of next 4 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 18 sts, 2 dc in each of next 3 sts Join

ROUND 3

Ch 3, 1 dc in same place with slip st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of next 18 sts, 2 dc in each of next 8 sts, 1 dc in each of next 18 sts, 2 dc in next 6 sts, join (68)

ROUND 4

Ch 1, working in back loop only, 1 sc in each st around, join (68)

ROUND 5

Ch 1, sc in each st working through both loops of sts.

ROUND 6

Ch 4, *skip 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, ch 1; repeat from * around end with slip st in 3rd st of ch; (34 ch~1 spaces)

ROUND 7

Ch 4 * skip ch 1, 1 dc in next dc, ch 1; repeat from * around, end with slip at in 3rd st of ch.

ROUND 8

Ch 1, 1 sc in st with slip st. * 2 sc in each space around, end with sl st in last sc (68 st) fasten, break yarn.

INSTEP

Mark center of toe, from right side join yarn 17 sts before center of toe. ch 2, 1 dc in same space * yo, insert hook from front to back in space between ch and dc repeat from * 3 times more, draw up a loop through sc. At base of dc and draw through all loops on hook, ch 1 --a puff stitch; -- skip 2 sc, 1 dc in next st, repeat puff st, 12 puffs in all. ch 5, 1 sc on top of first puff st, 1 sc on top of each puff, slip in next ch. fasten, break yarn.

STRAP

Mark center back. ch 16, from wrong side.. Work 1 sc 3rd st before mark and next 5 sts.

ROW

1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each st to end

ROW 2

Ch 1, turn. 1 sc in each sc. Ch 7, slip st to foundation ch for button loop; fasten off.

NOTE:

Work loop in 2nd slipper on opposite end. From right side, with top of slipper toward you, work 1 row sc around sole inserting hook through front loop of st left free in 4th round.

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BABY BOOTIES 2

MATERIALS:

Hook: Size F

Baby Weight or Sport Weight Yarn
Yarn Needle
Cording or Ribbon or crochet chain (2-16" pieces)
Stitches used: ch, sl st, sc, sc dec, dc.
FL = Front Loops Only

Difficulty: EASY

(Don't forget to make 2)

ROW 1: Ch 30, sc in 2nd ch from hk and in each rem ch. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: 2 sc in FL only of same st as turning ch. Sc in FL only of each st across to last st. 2 sc in FL only of last st. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc in FL only of each st. Ch 1, turn.

ROWS 4-7: Rep Row 3.

ROW 8: Working in FL's only for this row. Sc Dec over next 2 sts. Sc in each rem st across to last 2 sts. Sc Dec over last 2 sts. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 9: Sc in FL only of each st.

FASTEN OFF leaving a 10" strand of yarn to be used for sewing.

Fold piece with short sides together. Thread the 10" strand of yarn through the yarn needle and stitch the short sides together. Also stitch along the foundation chain, joining the corresponding sts.

FASTEN OFF.

< CUFF >

Reattach yarn at the point where you fastened off earlier. Sl st the outside loops tog of the first 6 corresponding sts. Ch 3, Do Not Turn.

ROW 1: Dc in the FL of each st around the opening. Do Not Join. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 2: *Fpdc around post of next dc. Bpdc around post of next dc. Rep from * around. Do Not Join. Ch 4, turn.

ROW 3: Sc in FL only of next st. * Ch 4, sc in FL only of next st. Rep from * around.

FASTEN OFF.

< TIE STRING >:

I used a shiny cord for the tie but you can use a crocheted string or a ribbon. Cut a 16" piece for each bootie and weave it in and out of the stitches on the first row of the cuff. Using the sewing needle and coordinating thread, stitch the center of the tie string in place so the baby cannot pull it free from the bootie.

EASY CROCHET CAP AND BOOTIES

Abbreviations:

| | | | |
|----------------------|---------------------|---------------------|----------------|
| blo = back loop only | lp = loop | sl st = slip stitch | tog = together |
| ch = chain | sc = single crochet | sp = space | |
| dc = double crochet | sk = skip | st = stitch | |

Materials: 1/2 ounce soft baby yarn in 2 colors (i.e., blue and white)
Crochet hook sizes E (for preemie size), F (for newborn size) and G (for 3-6 month size)
Yarn needle or tapestry needle

Gauge: Using F hook, 5 sc equal 1 inch, 6 sc rows equal 1 inch

All rows are worked in the **BACK LOOP ONLY (blo)** of each st to create ribbing for stretchability.

You may alternate colors, working two rows of one color and two rows of another. When changing colors, work new color in last two lps of ending sc of previous color. Do not fasten off when changing color: carry across.

CAP: With one color, ch 35.

Row 1: SC in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each st across, ch 1, turn (34 sc).

Rows 2-56: SC in blo of each st across, ch 1, turn (34 sc).

Using tapestry or yarn needle, weave remaining yarn in end st of every other row along the 56 row portion, pull thread tightly and whipstitch to firmly secure top of cap crown. Do not fasten off. Holding wrong side of Row 1 and right side of Row 56 tog, sl st blo of Row 56 and Row 1 tog, matching sts. (These two rows can be whipstitched tog instead of using a yarn or tapestry needle.) Fasten off, weave in end. Make small pompom for crown or crochet a rosette.

ROSETTE: Ch 9, dc in 4th st from hook, 9 dc in same sp. Work 10 dc in each remaining st. Fasten off, pull both strands of yarn to wrong side of cap and knot several times. Rosette may be secured more firmly by stitching edges in several places.

BOOTIES:

Leg: Ch 15.

Row 1: (Wrong side of work) sc 2nd ch from hook, sc in each st across, ch 1, turn (14 sc).

Rows 2-20: Sc in blo of each st across, ch 1, turn (14 sc). At end of Row 20 do not fasten off.

Instep: With edge facing where color is carried across, join in end st of 8th row of leg.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in end st of next 4 rows, ch 1, turn (5 sc).

Rows 2-7: Sc in blo of each st across, ch 1, turn (5 sc). At end of Row 7 do not ch 1. Fasten off. Weave ends on wrong side.

Foot:

Row 1: With working yarn, sc in end st of next 8 rows of leg, sc in end st of next 7 rows of instep, sc in blo of next 5 sc, sc in end st of next 7 rows of instep, sc in end st of next 8 rows of leg, ch 1, turn (35 sc).

Rows 2-7: Sc in blo across, ch 1 turn (35 sc).

Row 8: Sk first st, sc in blo of next 14 sts, (sk one st, sc in blo of next st) 3 times, sc in blo of next 12 sts, sk one st, sl st in last st, ch 1, turn (29 sc).

Row 9: Sk first st, sc in blo of next 11 sts, (sk one st, sc in blo of next st) 3 times, sc in blo of next 10 sts, sk one st, sl st in last st, ch 1, turn (24 sc).

Row 10: Sk first st, sc in blo of next 12 sts. With right sides tog, sl st corresponding sts of bottn edges tog. Whipstitch remaining portion of foot and leg in same manner as cap. Fasten off, weave in ends.

BABY HAT

This cap was designed by Cindi Slatton and was added to this site with her permission on 10 Feb 01. She adapted this pattern from the one that I previously made. These work up really fast and are great for Charity!

Red Heart Baby Sport

Size "H" hook

Ch 6, join with sl st

Round 1: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, 2 hdc in each ch around. (12 hdc)

Round 2: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, 2 hdc in each hdc around, join (24 hdc)

Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, *hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc* around, join.

Round 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, *hdc in next 3 hadc, 2 hdc in next hdc* around. join.

Rounds 5-11: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around. Join.

Round 12: In front loops only, ch 1, sc in same st as joining, and in each hdc around, join.

Rounds 13-15: In both loops, sc in each sc around.

For a boys cap: Fasten off and weave in all ends

For a Girls Cap: **ch 3, sc in next sc** around. Turn up brim when finished.

Here are a couple of alternatives for a girls brim that Cindi came up with:

1. After doing 2 rounds of the sc's join as usual. ch 2, hdc in same st.* skip next st, hdc, dc in next st* repeat around.
2. OR do 3 rounds of sc's, join. next round, ch 1, sc, hdc, sc in joining stitch. *sk next st, sc, hdc, sc in next st* repeat around.

Crocheted Newborn Hat

SIZE: Fits newborn babies to 3 months.

MATERIALS: Lion Brand Jamie, or sport-weight yarn-less than one 1.75 oz. skein for one hat. Crochet hook size F, OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

GAUGE: 4 half double crochet=1"; 2 rows=1".

RUFFLED HAT: Loosely chain 25.

Row 1: Starting in third chain from hook, work 1 half double crochet in each chain across. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: Skip first half double crochet, work 1 half double crochet in each half double crochet across. Chain 2, turn.

Row 3: Work 1 half double crochet in first half double crochet, 2 half double crochet in each half double crochet across.

Row 4: Skip first half double crochet, work 1 half double crochet in each half double crochet across. Chain 3, turn. Repeat Row 4 until a total of 14 rows have been worked. Ch2, turn.

Ruffle: Work 3 half double crochet in each stitch across. Fasten off.

Finishing: With yarn needle and double yarn, draw a gathering thread through each stitch along foundation chain edge. Draw up to gather and tie securely. Sew back seam edges.

Pompon: Hole thumb and forefinger about 2" apart, wrap yarn around them 100 times. Tie center of the loops with a separate strand of yarn. Cut both ends of loop and trim. Sew securely to top of hat. Fold back last two rows for ruffle.

Plain Hat: Work as for Ruffled Hat for a total of 12 rows. Fasten off and finish as for Ruffled Hat.

Kathi Massey's Pattern for New Born Cap

(Kathi said these patterns are for left handed people, so we may need to alter it, - please let me know of any changes – melanie.bellavich@mindspring.com)

Cap:

Using a size F hook, chain 35.

Row 1: SC in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across (34 stitches). Ch 1, turn.

Row 2 - 56: Sc in blo* of each stitch across, ch 1, turn.

Slip stitch rows 1 and 56 together. End off leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and weave through every other row (don't worry about hitting all of them as there will be a hole in the top if you do). Pull tightly to close top of cap and tie a firm knot using ending tail and tail from end of beginning chain.

Ruffled Baby Cap

Materials:
Jamie Baby Yarn
Size G Hook

Ch 6, join with a sl st

Round 1: Ch 3, dc in first st with ch 3, 2 dc in each ch across. join with sl st. (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 3, dc in first st with ch 3, 2 dc in each ch across. Join with sl st. (24 dc)

Round 3: ch 3, dc in first st with ch 3, *dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc* around. Join with sl st.

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in first st with ch 3, * dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc* around. Join with sl st.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in first st with ch 3, * dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc* around. Join with sl st.

Round 6: Ch 3, dc in first st with ch 3, * dc in next 5 dc, 2 dc in next dc* around. Join with sl st.

Round 7: ch 3, dc in each dc around. Join with sl st.

Round 8-10 : repeat round 7.

Round 11: ch 1, sc in same st as ch 1, sc in each dc around. join with sl st to first sc. .

Round 12: ch 2 turn, working in BACK LOOPS only for this round, hdc in each st. across. Join.

Round 13: ch 2, **front post hdc in next st, back post hdc in next st** around. Join.

Round 14: ch 2. work hdc front post around each previous front post and hdc back post around each hdc back post around.....join.

Continue this pattern until the brim is as thick as you like it. Turn up brim.

Ruffle for a girls hat:

Round 12-14: repeat Round 9

Round 15: **ch 3 sc in next st** around. join at base of beg. ch. 3.

Fasten Off, weave in all ends, turn up brim.
