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REVERSIBLE BABY BLANKET

A super-soft, easy-care blanket that a beginner could knit. Finished blanket measures 35x45 inches and takes 18 ounces variegated pastel 4-ply knitting worsted, an 8 circular knitting needle.

GAUGE:

- 9 sts=2"

- 1 "V"=5"

Cast on 180 sts. K 1 row.

Pattern:

Row 1: K 3, (yo, k 10, k 2 tog twice, k 10, yo, k 1) 7 times, k 2.

Row 2: K 3, p to last 3 sts, k 3.

Row 3: K across row. (K first and last 3 sts every row for border.) Repeat these 3 pattern rows until all yarn is used, ending Row 3. Bind off in k at same tension. Block to size.



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BABY AFGHAN

(Sue Carroll)

MATERIALS

Worsted Weight Yarn: 22-1/2 oz. 31" Circular knitting needles, Size 7

Cast on 176 sts,

Row 1 & 2: Purl across

Row 3: (Right Side): P5, K1, YO, K1, P4, P2tog twice, P4, K1, *(YO, K1) Twice, P4, P2 tog twice, P4, K1; repeat from * across to last 6 sts, YO, K1, P5,

Row 4: Purl Across

Row 5: P5, K1, *YO, K2, P3, P2 tog twice, P3, K2, YO, K1; repeat from * to last 5 sts, P5

Row 6: Purl Across

Row 7: P5, K1, * YO, K3, P2, P2 tog twice, P2, K3, YO, K1; repeat from * across to last 5 sts, P5.

Row 8: Purl Across

Row 9: P5, K1, *YO, K4, P2 tog twice, P1, K4, YO, K1; repeat from * across to last 5 sts, P5.

Row 10: Purl Across

Row 11: P5, K1, YO, K5, P2 tog twice, K5, YO, K1; repeat from * across to last 5 sts, P5

Row 12: Purl Across

Row 13: P5, K1, YO, K1, P4, P2 tog twice, P4, K1, * (YO, K1) twice, P4, P2 tog twice, P4 K1, repeat from * across to last 6 sts, YO, K1, P5.

Repeat Rows 4-13 for pattern until Afghan measures approx. 36" from cast on edge, ending by working Row 11.

Last 2 Rows: Purl across.

Bind off all sts as to knit.

Super Easy Knit Blanket

Use any type yarn and needles appropriate for the yarn you choose.

For infant blankets, select soft yarns in pastel or primary colors.

Cast on 4 stitches.

1st Row: Knit 2, yarn over, knit to end

Repeat this row until sides measure 36 inches (you will have a triangle)

Decrease:

Knit 1, knit together, yarn over, knit 2 together

Repeat this row until 4 stitches remain on needle.

Knit 1 row. Bind off.

Another design:

Cast on 3 stitches.

Knit one row.

Knit 1 increase 1 in next stitch. Knit to end of row.

Repeat above row until side measures 36 inches.

Decrease:

Knit one, knit 2 together. Repeat to end of row.

When 3 stitches remain, knit one row. Bind off.

This pattern also makes a great dishcloth. Use cotton worsted weight yarn, and make sides 6 inches...they stretch a LOT when they are wet!

Knit Blanket Tumbling Blocks

20 Oz 4 ply knitting worsted yarn
9" circular needles

Makes blanket approx 36" x 38"

Cast on 130 stitches

Pattern is alternating KNIT blocks and PURL Blocks

Always KNIT side borders

1. KNIT 12 rows for bottom border.
2. Row 1: KNIT 10 stitches for side border. * KNIT 10 stitches, PURL 10 stitches *. Repeat * * until ten stitches from edge. KNIT final 10 stitches for other side border.
3. Row 2: KNIT 10 for border. *PURL 10, KNIT10*. Repeat * * until ten stitches from edge. KNIT final 10 stitches for other side border
4. Continue for 12 more rows (14 rows per "block"). There will be 11 alternating blocks that are approx 2 ½" square.
5. After the first row of blocks, reverse the pattern – KNIT 10 for border, begin with 10 PURL.
6. Continue until there are 14 rows of "blocks".
7. Knit 12 rows for top border.

Pattern

Wheat Ears Baby Afghan

Size:

Approximately 30" x 36"

Materials needed:

15 oz. 4-ply Red Heart Soft
yarn

Size 10 1/2 knitting needles

Directions:

Cast on 122 st. Pattern is a
multiple of 8 st with 10 st for
the side borders (5 st ea).



Rows 1-5: Knit.

Row 6 (wrong side): K5, p6,
k2, yo, sl 1, k1, pss0, (p4, k2,
yo, sl 1, k1, pss0) across to last
11 st, p6, k5.

Row 7: K11, p2, yo purlwise (bringing yarn end to front), p2
tog, (k4, p2, yo purlwise, p2 tog) across to last 11 st, k11.

Rows 8-13: Repeat rows 6-7 three more times.

Row 14: K5, p2, k2, yo, sl 1, k1, pss0, (p4, k2, yo, sl 1, k1,
pss0) across to last 7 st, p2, k5.

Row 15: K7, p2, yo purlwise, p2 tog, (k4, p2, yo purlwise, p2
tog) across to last 7 st, k7.

Rows 16-21: Repeat rows 14-15 three more times.

Repeat rows 6-21 until piece measures 35". Knit last 5 rows
and bind off.
