"give" with the baby. Another reason is that our supply of solid is massive and we are trying valiantly to pare it down, looking down the road in case there is another shipment from Garan.

* Another note on sewing/serging knit items, please make sure that the stretch goes the way the pattern dictates. Sometimes it is stretchy BOTH ways but more stretchy one way than the other. This again goes to not confining the baby and giving it all the room to move and make it easier for the mom to put on her baby as well.
