It is free for 2 months, but will be \$350/mo after that. SO we need to clear it out as soon as possible. We will go through it and then sell what we can't use.

We will have two work days this month. They will be Saturday May 13, and Wednesday May 17. Both will start at 9:00AM. They will probably go until 1 PM, so if you can't come early, come when you can.

We received a box of fabric and yarn from a woman in Maryland. She paid for the shipping.
