

BIB INSTRUCTIONS

July 2008

Woven cotton fabric or flannel for front
Terry Cloth or 2 layers of flannel for back
1 snap

DO NOT USE BATTING IN BIBS.

Lay back right side up. If using flannel you will have 2 layers.

Lay front right side down. (Right sides together).

Begin stitching at bottom leaving a 2-3" opening. Large enough to turn inside out. Stitch around using 3/8" to 1/2" seam.

Trim fabric along edge of top (bib pattern). Clip neck and tab curves as necessary to lay flat.

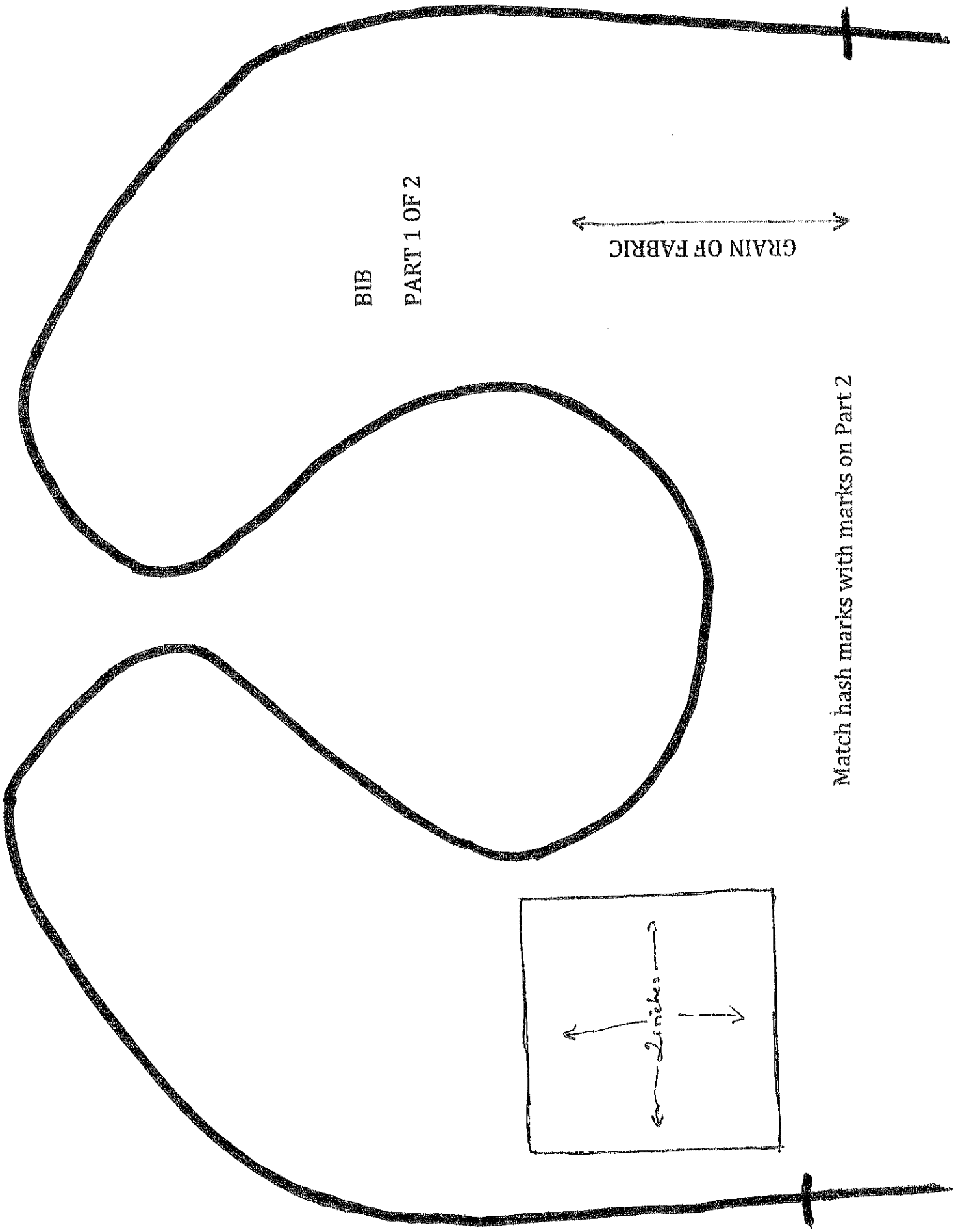
Turn right side out through opening.

Slip stitch opening closed.

Press well using steam.

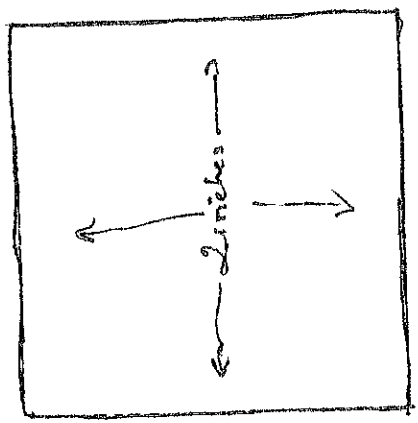
Top stitch 3/8 to 1/2 " from edge all around.

Put 1 snap on tab. Make sure snap is secure. Sometimes the terry causes the snap to come loose.
