

QUILTS

July 2008

Size should be 36" x 45"

Woven fabric for front and back

If piecing, squares of flannel can be used for front

Flannel is acceptable for backing

Quilts should be stitched about ½" from edge and top stitched 4" to 6" apart to anchor fabric and batting. DO NOT TIE!

If using a quilt panel - the design will dictate where stitching is placed but make sure it is sufficient to anchor fabric and batting.

PILLOWCASE QUILT INSTRUCTIONS

July 2008

Size should be 36" x 45" when finished.

Place batting on flat surface.

Place quilt top on batting right side up.

Place quilt lining on top wrong side up.

Pin securely.

Stitch 4 sides with narrow seam leaving an opening approximately 4".

Remove pins.

Trim away excess batting.

Turn right sides out through opening. Push corners out.

Slip stitch opening closed.

Place on flat surface and smooth all layers before pinning securely.

Lengthen machine stitch. Top stitch 4" to 6" apart to anchor fabric and batting.
