Dream Makers Youth Foundation (DMYF) needs volunteers to help work the concession stands during the PGA Tour Championship held at The East Lake Country Club from September 22nd – 26th. Proceeds will help fund their S.T.A.R.S. Adaptive Sports Program for children with special needs; this program has two basketball seasons each year, and year-round tennis lessons. Thus far, these programs have been offered free of charge!

In order for DMYF to be successful, and for them to be able to continue to offer free programming to children with special needs, your support is essential!

For every DMYF volunteer who completes a full shift, a percentage of the concession stand earnings made throughout the entire tournament, will be contributed to Dream Makers Youth Foundation. Volunteers must wear dress pants, a white shirt, and comfortable shoes. They will be picked up and dropped off via shuttle buses from Turner Field, where volunteers can park free of charge!
