He spent many countless hours training the members of this department and others from surrounding counties so that we could protect others as well as ourselves.

This award will be presented each year to a person who is a member or have a family member associated with a volunteer emergency services organization in Mecklenburg County. This person must be a resident of Mecklenburg County and have at least a 2.5 grade point average. They must be of good character and accepted by an accredited college. They must be recommended by two teachers and write a 500-word essay of how emergency services organizations benefit the community. They may also be a current student in an accredited college and with payment being made directly to the college.

The amount of this scholarship will be (\$1,500.00) One thousand five hundred dollars. The funding being provided by the South Hill Volunteer Fire Department, the South Hill Volunteer Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary, & Larrie Matthews.

It is through this scholarship that Jimmy's memory will always live on.
