Biblical Authority



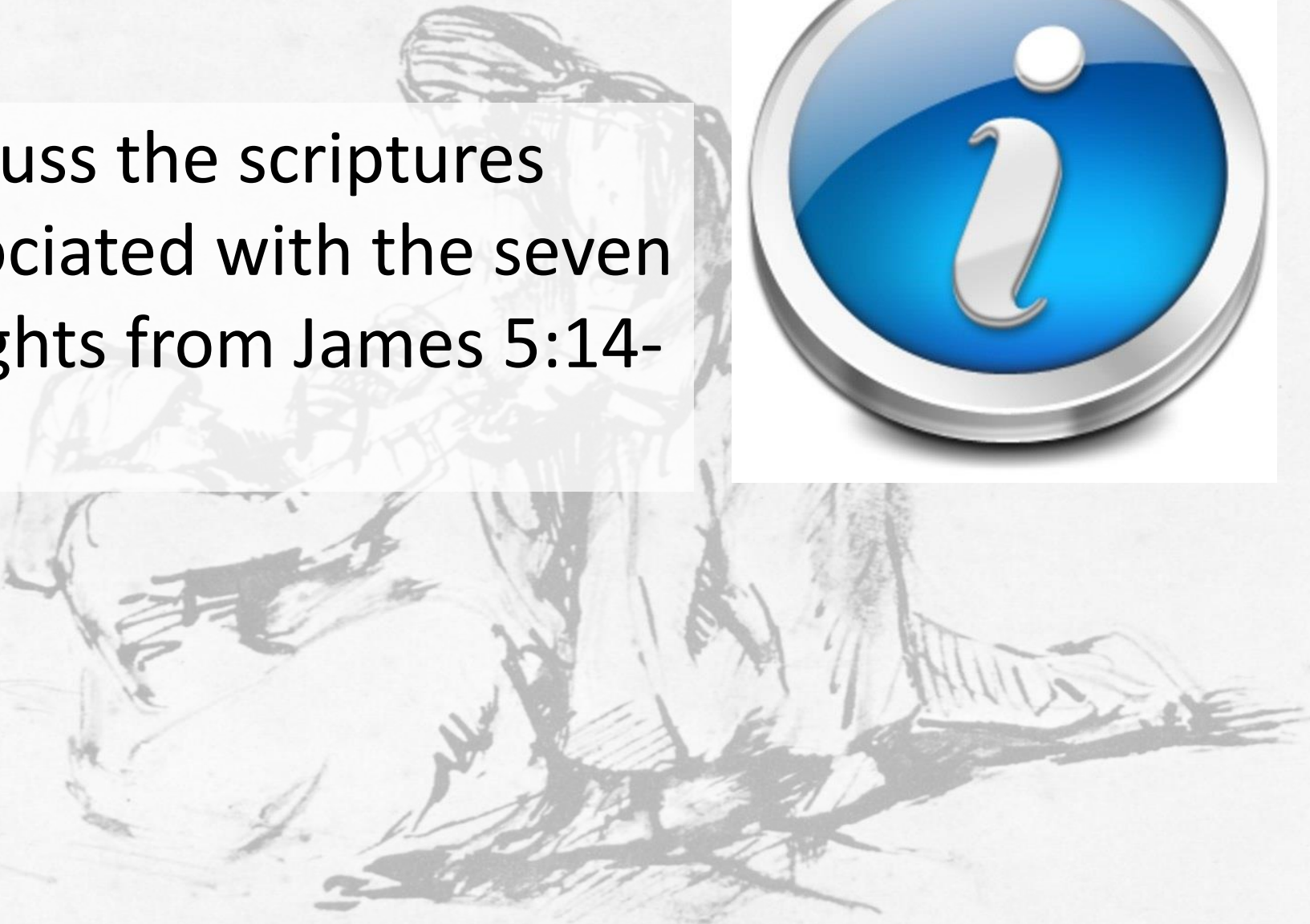

Seven Insights:



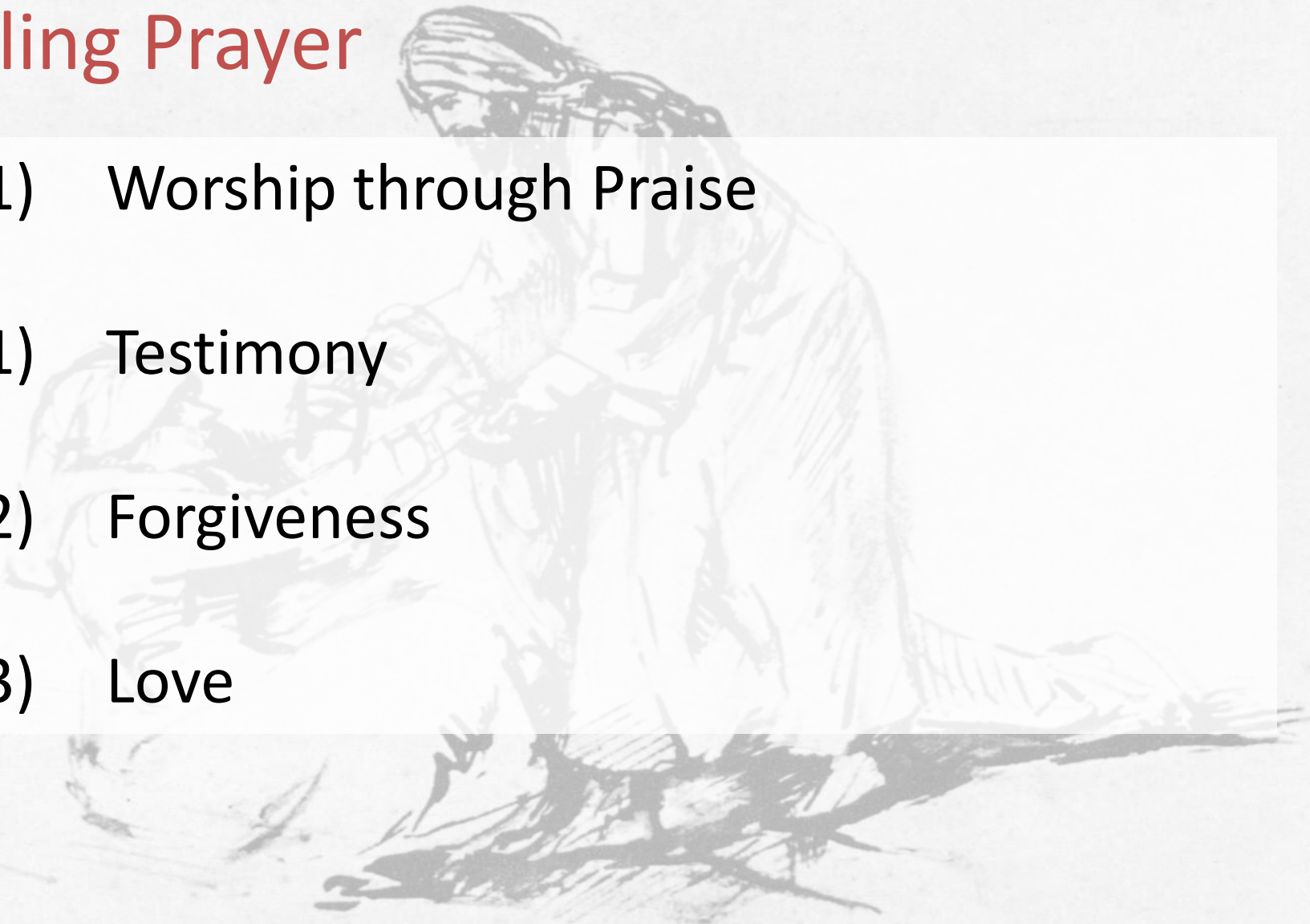
- 1) Call on those with spiritual maturity and authority
- 2) Oil as a symbol of the Holy Spirit
- 3) Pray in Jesus' name
- 4) Pray in faith
- 5) Confess sin
- 6) Extend forgiveness
- 7) Pray in right standing with God

Effective Components in Healing Prayer

- 1) Worship through Praise
- 1) Testimony
- 2) Forgiveness
- 3) Love
