First Things First...

Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. Romans 6:3-4

"I once was lost, but now I'm found, was blind but now I see!" If we were to have a game of "Name That Hymn," most people could name those lyrics as being taken from "Amazing Grace." Did you know that there are seven verses of Amazing Grace? Most people can recognize four of the seven but have no clue regarding the other three. One is relatively well-known:

The Lord has promised good to me, His Word my hope secures;

He will my shield and portion be, as long as life endures.

The two lesser-known verses continue:

Yes, when this flesh and heart shall fail, and mortal life shall cease,

I shall possess, within the veil, a life of joy and peace.

The world shall soon dissolve like snow the sun refuse to shine,


But God, who called me here below, shall be forever mine.

Sometimes, we think we know everything there is to know about a subject, a person, and even biblical teachings. In the richness and depth of God's Word we never fully grasp everything there is to glean, even in a single verse or two. Read again Romans 6: 3-4. Did you realize that in baptism the Holy Spirit brings death and gives life? In baptism the old Adam within us is crucified with Christ; the new Adam within us is brought to life through the resurrection of Jesus. What a marvelous truth to understand: in baptism we are delivered from sin and death to become a new creation in Christ Jesus. When the Holy Spirit is ready to reveal a new insight, we often find ourselves marveling that we had never realized a particular truth in our previous studies. The revelation we gain in Bible study is exactly what we need when we need it.

On the last Sunday of March, we celebrate my favorite day of the year. We rejoice in worship on the festival day called both Easter and Resurrection Day. Personally, I like calling it the SONrise Celebration. It is the culmination of Christ's redemptive work on earth. I remain continually amazed by the grace of God as He revealed His salvation for me. Truly, I do not understand why God chose me to hear and receive the gospel of Jesus Christ. I am utterly humbled by the love He showered on me, adopting me as the heir to His promises. No other day should receive our commitment to worship, to praise, and to adore the God of our salvation.

I encourage you to make every effort, laying aside anything that might prevent your attendance at worship on March 31st. It is the least that we can do in appreciation for all that God has done for us.


We are gearing up for our school Easter egg hunt on Friday, March 22nd. Everyone is so excited about celebrating our risen Savior!
