"... Since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God; for 'all flesh is like grass and all its glory like the flower of grass, the grass withers, and the flower falls, but the word of the Lord remains forever.' And this word is the good news that was preached to you." 1 Peter 1: 22-25



The follower of Christ still inhabits a body of flesh. The struggle with temptation is very real. The work of building a life through the Word of God continues daily that we might show the world, that while we are flawed, we are forgiven and continually being drawn nearer to the likeness of our Savior. Paul illustrates this saying: "Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Brothers, I do not consider it that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:12-14) We are all works in progress, not to our detriment, but to God's glory.

Beloved of the Lord, abide in his word knowing that through the power of the Holy Spirit you are being changed daily to be more like Jesus.

As always, remember this: Jesus loves you and so do I!






