First Things First...

Now Elijah the Tishbite, from Tishbe in Gilead, said to Ahab, "As the LORD, THE God of Israel lives, whom I serve, there will be neither dew nor rain in the next few years except at my word."

1 Kings 17:1

It is hot and dry! Social media is replete with "cute" quotes about the heat and drought in Texas. Serious as it may be, this climate condition pales when compared to the drought Elijah announced to Ahab. Jesus revealed that the rain disappeared for three years and six months (Luke 4:25). Solomon, in the Spirit, received from the Lord, "When I shut up the heavens so that there is no rain, or command the locust to devour the land, or send pestilence among my people, if my people who are called by my name humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and forgive their sin and will heal their land." (2 Chronicles 7:13-14) I propose all three harmful conditions plague our nation today.

That a drought exists is easily seen. Referring to a map depicting drought conditions, one finds over half of the nation experiencing abnormally dry conditions, with large swaths of the western U.S. having extreme or exceptional drought. Much of the country's food and fiber production is experiencing both short- and long-term effects because the "heavens are shut up."

Likewise, the pestilence assaulting humans can readily be found. COVID-related illnesses, monkeypox, the first recorded case of polio to be diagnosed in several decades, cancer, heart diseases, neurological syndromes/diseases...this list could extend to extreme lengths. Both old and new health problems attack people of all ages. This includes those diseases generated through flagrant disregard of God's created and intended morality (see Romans 1:18-32). Plagues have not ceased, but a case can easily be presented revealing the multiplying and intensifying of pestilence.

At least locusts are not devouring our land...or are they? The food supply was disappearing before the drought began. Shortages of many consumer products are becoming the norm. Inflation and production costs eat away at any income, earned or produced. The day will come when the federal government must increase taxation to offset its largess because there seems to be no limit to the spending budgets being formulated. Children are indoctrinated with a corrupted pseudo-history and anti-Biblical morality, both in school curriculum and through current social and entertainment media. False gods are exalted, while the TRUE GOD is vilified and ridiculed. These "locusts" and many others are devouring the land.

Despite that negativity, we have hope and instruction to turn around these dire circumstances! It is a call to those identifying by the name of the One-True God. That is by those calling themselves "Christian." They are to be humble, confessing that in and of themselves, they can do nothing. They rely only and completely on their Heavenly Father. They pray fervently and regularly. Singularly and corporately: they pray. At home and in the congregation: they pray. They pray asking forgiveness for themselves and the nation. They seek God's face: reading, studying, and discussing the Bible to know the Lord and His will. They examine themselves and leave behind any worldliness, no longer conforming to this world but being transformed into the image of Christ through the renewing of the mind by the power of the Holy Spirit (see Romans 12-14). In such a Christ-centered, Spirit-fueled relationship, the Father will heal the land! As the gospel song declares: "It is no secret what God can do. What He's done for others, He'll do for you. With arms wide open, He'll pardon you. It is no secret what God can do."*



First School And Day Care



FLCEC Manna Meals Team


