
Isaiah 52:7

However, in Job 38:1-40:2, God has left us a record of how great He is, how far beyond our comprehension, how awesome He is. Well, we may not live where we can see the mountains, but His Majesty, His Glory, His Power, His Perfection are easily visible all around us if we simply stop and take notice of Him.

Take a moment to seek the Lord while He may be found (Deuteronomy 4:29; 1Chronicles 22:19; Isaiah 55:6; et al). He promises that you will find him when you seek him with all your heart (ibid).


