PRELUDE

CALL TO WORSHIP (Responsive):

Pastor: Today we recall the events of the first Palm Sunday, many years ago.

PRAYER OF INVOCATION (Unison):

Almighty God, today is the start of the somber but holy week that marks Jesus' betrayal, arrest and death on the cross, when the people who cried "Hosanna!" as he rode into Jerusalem on a donkey shouted "Crucify him!" in front of Pontius Pilate only a few days later. Help us to discern the deeper meaning of this Gospel story as we remember the darkest time in human history, when violence seemed to triumph over peace and evil over good; but because of what you did on Easter, they did not. Bless us with your presence here this morning, O Lord, and give us eyes of faith that see in Jesus' suffering and life-giving sacrifice the power of your love that culminated with Jesus' resurrection. We ask these things in the name of Christ our Savior, who taught us to pray like this, saying:
