Who does this Privacy Policy apply to?

The Lord Monckton Foundation collects personal information from a variety of sources. The Lord Monckton Foundation does not collect sensitive information. This Privacy Policy applies to any personal information collected by The Lord Monckton Foundation about:

- prospective employees
- clients
- individuals who are donors or contributors to The Lord Monckton Foundation
- business partners
- suppliers
- contractors
- members
- other people who may come into contact with The Lord Monckton Foundation Limited though its network

The Lord Monckton Foundation is not bound by the NPPs in relation to its treatment of employee records if the treatment is directly related to a current or former employment relationship between The Lord Monckton Foundation and an employee.

Requests for Personal Information

In any area of our website where The Lord Monckton Foundation asks you to provide personal information that will enable us to enhance your site visit or to follow up with you after your visit.

It is completely optional for you to participate and to give this information. For example, we request information from you when you:

Disclosure of Information

The Lord Monckton Foundation does not sell, rent, loan, trade, or lease any personal information collected at our site. This includes any licensing forms or e-mail lists.

The Lord Monckton Foundation may provide access to personal information without your consent only in certain prescribed circumstances, including but not limited to:

- specified Commonwealth and State agencies and to comply with legislative requirements
- law enforcement
- lessening or preventing a serious and imminent threat to an individual's life, health or safety or a serious threat to public health or public safety
